#### Who are we?

**The Exoneration Project** is a not-for-profit organization operating a legal clinic at the University of Chicago Law School. We represent people asserting their innocence in state and federal post-conviction proceedings.

#### What kind of cases do we work on?

The Exoneration Project represents clients claiming their innocence in state and federal post-conviction proceedings.

#### How does the application process work?

The Exoneration Project will use this application to decide whether your case is a good fit for the Project. The first step in our application process is filling out this packet. Once we review your application, we will contact you with any questions we have about your case. If we do not think that your case is a good fit for our organization, we will send you a denial letter.

#### How long does it take you to review my case?

We will contact you within **one year** to let you know if we have any questions about your case. We are working as hard as we can to review cases, but due to the number of applications we receive, there is an average response time of one year.

If there is important information regarding updates on your case that you need to tell us after you send in your application, please use the form provided at the back of this packet.

#### How can I check on my case status?

Unfortunately, we are unable to respond to requests for confirmation of delivery of applications, or requests for case status updates due to the amount of requests we receive.

### Should I send documents and transcripts?

No. Please do not send **any** documents with your application. Please list any documents in your possession (or any documents you think would be helpful to your case) on Page 13. If we would like to review a document, we will write to you and request that you send that document to us.
