The Task

- Advise and cooperate with Religion, Science & The Environment (RSE) in Hungary as communications advisor of Symposium III "A River of Life" Down the Danube to the Black Sea, organized under the auspices of His All Holiness The Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew I and His Excellency Romano Prodi, President of the European Commission, and in particular support Plenary 5 "Times of transition. Rivers in transition: Setting the priorities" held in Budapest on October 21, 1999 in the following areas:
 - Act as communications advisor to position RSE as a key conservation organization committed to environmental ethics in Hungary as well,
 - Support the leadership of RSE standing for cooperation of religion, science and environment to strengthen environmental awareness,
 - Handle public affairs/government relations: liaise on behalf of RSE to approach relevant segments of the Hungarian community, especially government, local media and journalists, as well as scientific and conservation organizations,
 - Handle press relations.

Measures

- Planning and organizing the whole program of Symposium III whilst in Hungary, including the agenda of HAH The Ecumenical Patriarch as well as of Plenary 5;
- Securing the Hungarian Academy of Sciences as partner to host Plenary 5 meeting in its Ceremony Hall in Budapest;
- Organizing the visit of the Basilica of Esztergom for HAH The Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew I;
- Coordinating with HE Dr. Árpád Göncz, President of the Republic of Hungary in order to win him to address the attendees of Symposium III in Hungary;
- Coordinating audience for HAH the Ecumenical Patriarch with the President of the Hungarian Parliament;
- Organizing the cultural visit and sightseeing of Budapest;
- Setting up the program of Plenary 5 with the professional support of the Ministry of Environment;
- Setting up VIP and press invitee lists, producing, mailing and following up invitations to Plenary 5,
- On-going media relations:
 - Setting up media list for the press conference and Plenary 5 in Budapest.
 - Translating, adapting, producing and distributing press release prior to the event,
- Developing, producing and distributing information materials (press release and background information) to selected media and journalists during event;
- Media monitoring and analyses.
