June Kids Fishing Contest

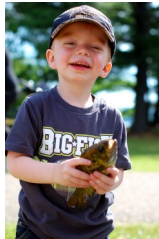

Park Information

Willow River State Park has become one of the most popular parks in Wisconsin. With easy accessibility from Interstate 94, its 3000+ acres offers much for park visitors.

A large waterfall is the park's main attraction with views of deep gorges, 3 high overlooks, and breathtaking panoramas. There is a stairway to the overlook next to the beautiful waterfall. A secluded family campground developed in a wooded area of the park was designed with camper privacy in mind. Two other new campgrounds with more room for the larger RV's are now open.

Visit the Nature Center and check out the displays, or take a hike on one of the many trails. The OWLs organization offers firewood for sale and canoe and kayak rentals from the main Park Office.

Try your hand at fishing on one of the three new fishing piers purchased by the friends group and installed by the dam.

Winter enthusiasts will also find Willow River State Park a busy place. Groomed ski trails are the winter highlight of the park. Ice fishing and snowshoeing are also growing in popularity. Join us for our candle light ski and hike in February.
