Technical rider & Stage plan Warum Nicht!

Five musicians (Nico, Steffen, Sebastian, Felix and Fabien)

Drums Accordion
Cajon Saxophone
Electric guitar Trombone
Bass guitar 2 Vocals

We assume that there is a well sized PA system provided for the concert room with an adapted mixing desk and a monitor system. It is important that the singers and the drummer each have their own monitor speakers with separate mixes.

Stage Setup:

Drums

No microphone needed. For larger rooms we need one microphone for the kick, for even bigger rooms two overheads, one snare microphone, one hi-hat microphone.

Cajon

We have our own system (t.bone SC140). Requires 48V Phantom Power

Electric guitar

We have our own amp (Marschall All Tube Combo), we need an amp-mic (type Shure SM57)

Bass

We have our own amp (Hartke) with DI output

Accordion

We have our own system (AKG C516ML, one single standard mic-XLR output)

Saxophone

No microphone needed. For larger rooms one microphone with stand

Vocals

Two mics with stands (type SM58).

We will need a sound engineer (we do not have a regular engineer, so we depend on the staff onsite). If a good drumset and/or a bass amp are already available on-site, that's good: we do not need to bring our own. We can share our material (drums, amps) but this has to be discussed before the show. If needed we can bring our own SM58 microphones for the vocals.
