About The British School of Brussels

The British School of Brussels (BSB) is an international school founded in 1969 in Brussels and established in 1970 in Tervuren. It is an all-through, non-selective school for students from 1 - 18 years with 1,200 currently on roll. Truly international in dimension, the students represent over 65 nationalities. 41% of students are British. The School offers a British-based curriculum up to the age of 16, (I)GCSE. This is adapted to our European context and international cohort and is followed by the choice of two internationally recognised pre-university examination courses from age 16 -18 – English A Level and the International Baccalaureate Diploma. We also offer a range of vocational courses including the IBCC and BTEC.

The School has a bilingual French/English programme for children of 4-9 years of age and extensive bilingual French/English opportunities in its Secondary School. These complement the English-medium teaching.

Extensive provision for Learning Support and English as an Additional Language (EAL) is available, together with a wide range of extra-curricular activities. Facilities at the School are impressive.

Academic standards are very high. In 2011, our IB results were outstanding. 15.2% of the students passed with the highest marks of 40 or over, compared to just 5.3% on average globally. The 2011 pass rate for the IB Diploma was a superb 87.9% and close to 38% of students sitting A Levels scored 'A' grade or higher;

an excellent statistic for a non-selective school. In 2011 in Primary School, 96% of children in Year 6 achieved Level 4 and above in Mathematics. 54% of the children achieved a Level 5 in English indicating attainment levels above the national average.
