Bella is a 4-year old Black-British girl of Caribbean heritage; she lives in a cul-de-sac in the leafy suburbs of north London with her parents Sandra and Theo. She is a free spirit; always fun to be around, warm, kind and considerate; she is always happy, from the moment readers meet Bella they will fall in love with her cheeky personality and zest for life

Working as a voluntary tutor for children aged 4+ in her local community, Lorraine O'Garro was inspired to create Bella after noticing how few black, mixed-race and ethnic minority characters featured in books for young children. As a result, **The Alphabet with Bella** is written as an alternative to the norm, both teaching the alphabet and introducing children to new cultures and worldliness.

Complimented by bold and colourful illustrations, **The Alphabet with Bella** is the first in The Bella Series of books for children aged 2-5 years, and is perfect for parents, family members and primary school educators to read and learn together with young children.

About the author: Lorraine O'Garro is the author of The Bella Series, a colourful and charismatic early learning tool for children, designed to help them develop using accessible role models to foster positive self-image and confidence. O'Garro is a qualified accountant and the founder of new menswear brand Hashtag Collective.
