During his twenty-nine years at AT&T he held a variety of positions including National Account Executive in Kansas City, Missouri and in Las Vegas, Nevada. He ended his career with AT&T in 1998 as Country Manager for Vietnam, Cambodia, and Laos which allowed him to live and work with the Vietnamese people. He then became the National Account Manager for Sprint until the Lord called him in to the ministry in 2005.

In 2010 Michael and his wife, Lori, joined the Country Gospel Music Association and began their own ministry, Beauty for Ashes.
