Guide for Contributors

Legal scholars and practitioners are invited to submit articles on current legal developments, overviews of newly adopted legislation, analysis of case law and book reviews for the publication in GLR. Furthermore students are encouraged to submit their contributions for Students Forum of GLR.

Contents Requirements

Contributions submitted for publication should have direct relevance to the priority fields provided for by the PCA. The Board of Editors accept contributions based upon their significance, quality and a possible impact on legal developments in Georgia.

Technical Requirements

Any contribution should be in hard and electronic copies in either Georgian or English. The fonts shall be for Georgian text - AcadNusx and for English one – Arial. Size of the fonts used in the text of contributions shall be 10, that of footnotes - 8. Articles should normally range from 8 to 20 pages in length and other contributions not more 5 pages, single space.

Editorial Policy

Notifications of acceptance, rejection or need for revisions will be given within eight weeks upon receipt of the contribution. The decision of the Board will be final. The Board of Editors reserves the right to suggest modifications or seek additions to all materials accepted for publication, and further reserves the right at any time to reject or to postpone the publication of any material. All materials accepted for publication may, at the discretion of the Board of Editors, be subjected to linguistic and grammatical revision.

Copyright

Contributions submitted should be accompanied by an assurance that the article or any other contribution has not been (wholly or partly) published, submitted or accepted for publishing in any other publication. Copyright is exclusively vested in the GLR and the author(s) jointly.
