THAT IN AN EGALITARIAN SOMEWHEREVILLE IT WOULD BE THE LAW THAT

Individual Membership in the Sharing Economy is Voluntary

- The sharing economy is a mutual agreement among people to work reasonably in the economy according to ability and to take freely (or receive as equitably rationed in the case of scarcity) from the economy according to reasonable need or desire.
- Any person or group of people may choose not to be members of the sharing economy.
- Non-members of the sharing economy may own personal property and as much land and other things as they can, by themselves alone, reasonably use to produce goods and/or services for themselves or to barter with individuals or enterprises in the sharing economy.
- In any economic enterprise, in or outside the sharing economy, all workers have an equal say in decision-making and an equal standard of living: inherently unequal employeremployee relations are not allowed.

*An egalitarian is any person who supports:

- Equality (in the sense of "no rich and no poor," not "equal opportunity" to get richer than others) and
- Mutual Aid (or Solidarity, meaning helping each other, not being pitted against others in competition by an oppressor to control us)

All egalitarians (and only egalitarians) of Somewhereville are invited and encouraged to attend the Local Assembly and participate as equals in writing the ONLY laws that residents of Somewhereville must obey in an egalitarian society.
