School Policies Are Set Only by those who Reside or Work in Somewhereville

- As long as schools abide by Local Assembly* laws, the
 policies of a particular school shall be determined by, and
 only by, a school assembly open to all the school's teachers,
 staff, parents of students in the school and adult students in the
 school (if any).
- The assembly shall operate democratically in a manner of its own choosing with every participant having equal formal status.
- Schools shall promote the egalitarian values of equality and mutual aid, and provide an education that prepares students to help one another and the rest of society to the best of their ability—and to compete against others only for fun in sports, games and contests, not dog-eat-dog competition in the global economy.

society. An egalitarian is any person who supports:

• Equality (in the sense of "no rich and no poor," not "equal opportunity" to get richer than others) and

• Mutual Rid (or Solidarity, meaning helping each other, not being pitted against others in competition

All Education, pre-K through PhD, is Free

- Any person in good standing may attend school for free, from pre-K through PhD.
- All persons are in good standing unless the Local Assembly of Egalitarians determines that, after taking into account the particular circumstances and reasonableness, they are violating the principle of "from each according to ability, to each according to need."
- Getting an education counts as reasonable work, *i.e.*, contributing according to ability.
- Egalitarians are those who support equality (no rich and no poor) and mutual aid.
