THAT IN AN EGALITARIAN SOMEWHEREVILLE IT WOULD BE THE LAW THAT

School Policies Are Set Only by those who Reside or Work in Somewhereville

- As long as schools abide by Local Assembly* laws, the policies of a particular school shall be determined by, and only by, a school assembly open to all the school's teachers, staff, parents of students in the school and adult students in the school (if any).
- The assembly shall operate democratically in a manner of its own choosing with every participant having equal formal status.
- Schools shall promote the egalitarian values of equality and mutual aid, and provide an education that prepares students to help one another and the rest of society to the best of their ability—and to compete against others only for fun in sports, games and contests, not dog-eat-dog competition in the global economy.
