During normal use Smart Casual Dress may be worn. When used as a function room the function will dictate the dress and the dress code for the function will be clearly stated on the tickets and the notices posted in the Clubhouse advertising the function.

2. Bar Lounge (19th Hole), Dining Room and Centenary Lounge

Smart Casual Dress may be worn at all times.

3. Snooker Room

Only adults reaching the age of 18 are allowed in the Snooker Room. Visitors may use this facility until 1900 hours after which it is reserved for members and their guests. Food must not be consumed in the Snooker Room.

4. Dining Facilities

Sandwiches, cakes and Bar Snacks may be consumed in the 19th Hole and on the Patio. All other meals must be consumed in the Jack Hulley lounge, Dining Room or Centenary lounge.

5. Tailored Golf Shorts

Tailored Golf Shorts may be worn prior to and after playing golf in the 19th and Centenary Lounge.

The following attire is not permitted in the Clubhouse: -

The wearing of soiled or wet clothing, golf shoes, rainwear, outdoor wear, headgear, trainers, men's sandals (with or without socks), stocking feet, denim jeans, denim shirts, trainers, track or leisure suit.

CARDS

Members may use their cards when attending any official Club function. Members may use their cards to purchase drinks for themselves and their personal guests when attending any private function. Members' cards may not be used as a general kitty card where visitors are included.

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in the Clubhouse.

Dress Code Policy

Proper attire must be worn by all golfers

For Men

Trousers, tailored golf shorts, with either Knee-length socks or white sports socks, collared golf shirts (mock turtle golf shirts are acceptable) worn inside the waistband.

For Ladies

Trousers, tailored golf shorts, golf skirts, collared shirts with or without sleeves, collarless shirts with sleeves, worn inside the waistband. Including the Ladies Upstairs Lounge prior to interclub matches.

Golf shoes must be worn at all times and golf headgear must be worn correctly.

The following attire is not permitted. Denim Jeans, Denim Shirts or Denim Shorts, T-Shirts, trainers, leisure or walking shoes.

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones may be used for diaries, internet access, email, GPS, texting and social networking.

The board confirm that a mobile phone can be used on the course for **GPS purposes only** and can be used in the Club House for all applications **other than phone calls** providing the phone is in silent mode.

Members are requested to either switch their phones off or place them into silent mode whilst on the course and/or in the Club House.

The Golf Course is not open for play until 0700hrs BST and 0730hrs GMT.
