We have so much to celebrate and so much to look forward to!

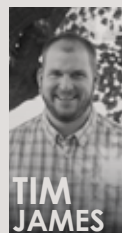

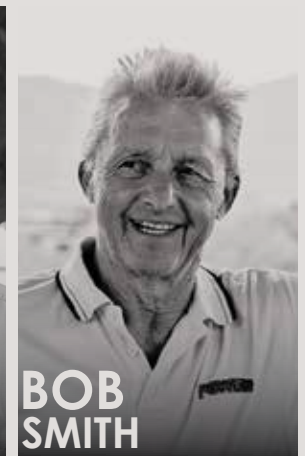
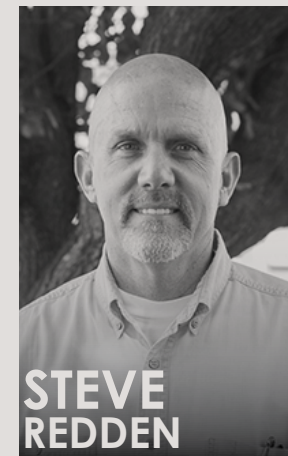
* This is General Giving toward Missions and Church Planting. Many will be called to give over and above their General Giving toward specific ministries and projects.
