July 20, 2016 Seattle – The **Seattle Acoustic Festival** is returning to Capitol Hill at the **All-Pilgrims Christian Church** for 3 days, from August 26th to 28th.

In year 4, the Seattle Acoustic Festival has become the largest,

independent, musician-powered festival on the West Coast, and is now a 3-day event, featuring the music of 68 artists.

As another major change, SAF is ambitiously letting audiences name their own ticket prices. “We wanted every person to be able to attend this festival, and we wanted people to know that musicians deserve their support, but that all fans who want to contribute can be a part of this,” says founding co-organizer, Paul Mauer.

The Seattle Acoustic Festival is also using a new tag line this year: “**Quiet is the new loud.**” Co-founder Elijah Dhavvan adds, “The festival is based on the idea that even the quiet, mellow, acoustic musicians of the area can elicit the most powerful emotional experiences for the audience.”

The Seattle Acoustic Festival emphasizes an intimate, up-close musical experience, with audience members able to find a more engaging connection with the musical artists. “We emphasize storytelling and sharing experiences through music,” says Dhavvan, “and we hope that audiences will come away with a unique appreciation for the songs that they love.”

Some of the most critically acclaimed musicians of the region are contributing their voices to SAF, like **Danny Newcomb, Tobias the Owl, Tekla Waterfield, Lonely Mountain Lovers, Shelita Burke, Gabriel Wolfchild**, and many, many more.
