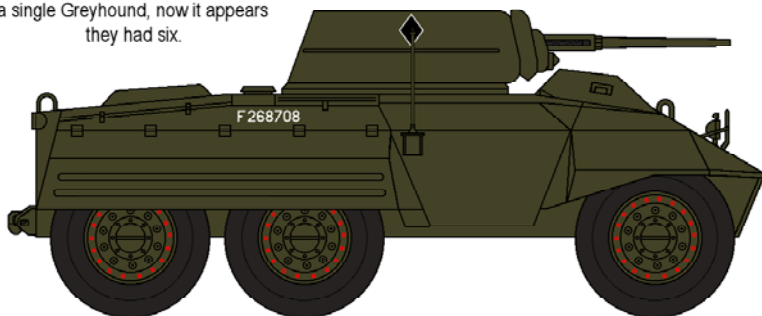

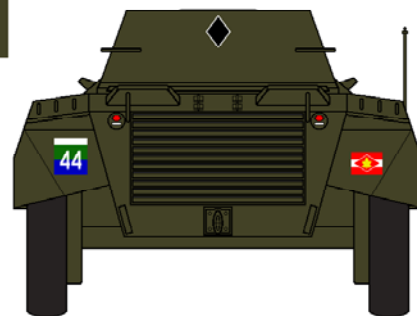
Initially I thought the RCD had only a single Greyhound, now it appears they had six.

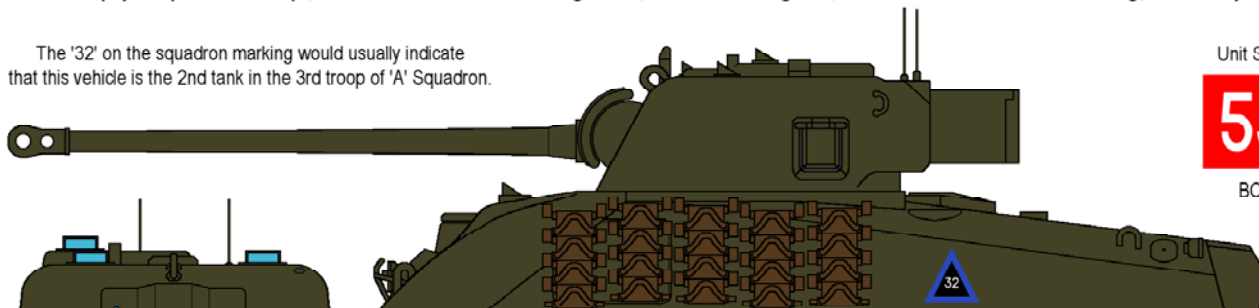

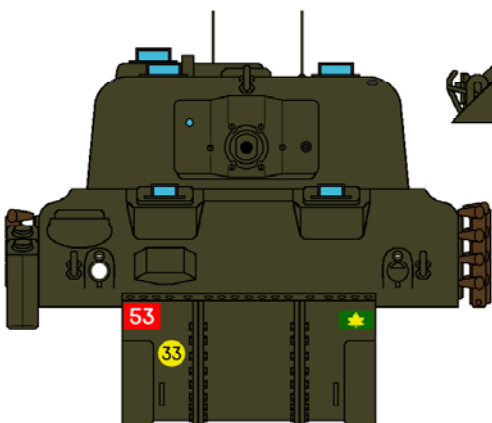
The '32' on the squadron marking would usually indicate that this vehicle is the 2nd tank in the 3rd troop of 'A' Squadron.

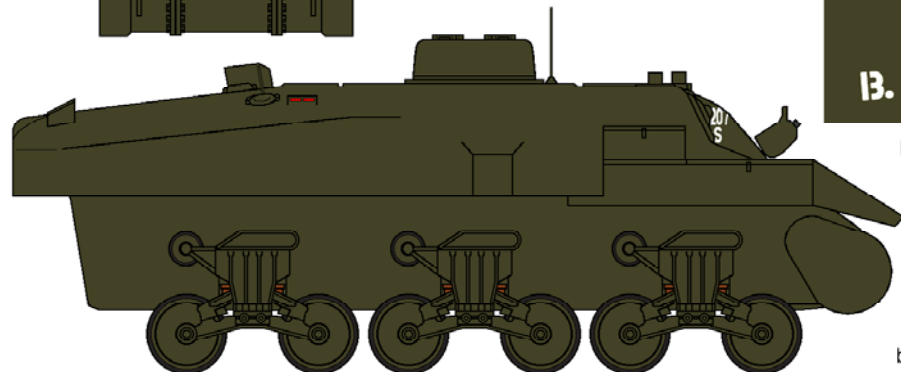
Hull Front Marking

Note the crumpled left front fender, also, the antennae are 8' but shown shorter here for the sake of space.

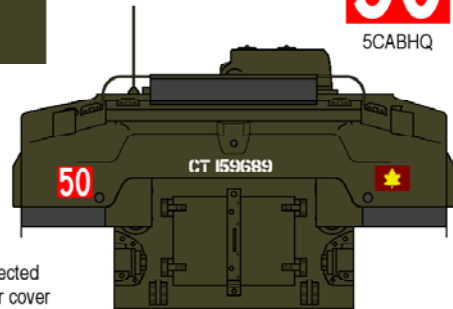

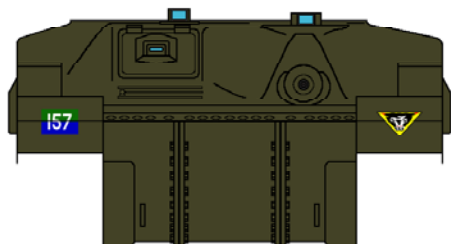

Kangaroos generally appeared rather dirty, both from the ground and from the troops climbing all over them.

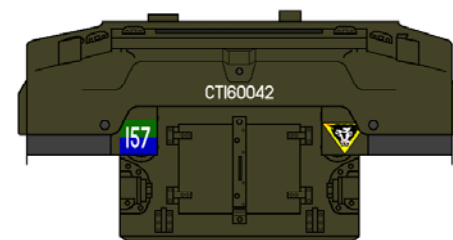

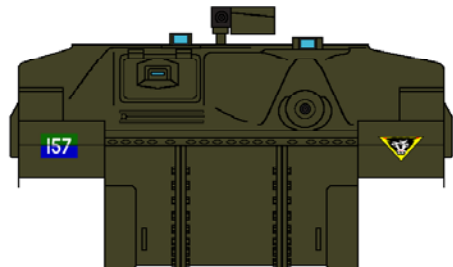

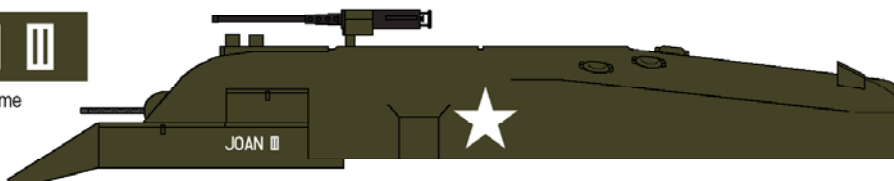

RCASC: Royal Canadian Army Service Corps, the Corps that provided transport and drivers for light and heavy lift jobs but did not carry troops into action.
