

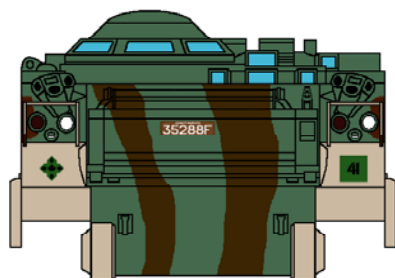

Although he will probably never admit it publicly (for reasons that will soon become clear) Gary Barling gave me a great deal of assistance (and resistance) in the making of this page.

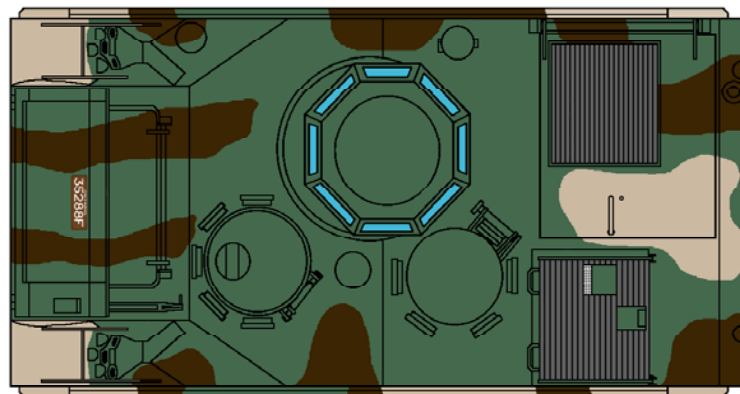


Formation Sign:

	Stone (RGB: 203/185/161 - CMYK: 14/19/30/0)
	Semi-Gloss Olive (RGB: 59/37/3 - CMYK: 65/90/94/29)
