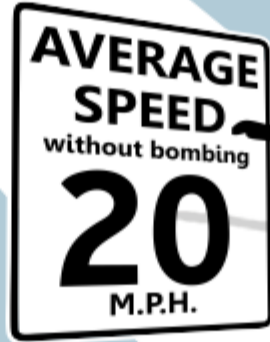
## ACCESSORY MAN

**2011** almost every third U.S. snow sports enthusiast is a snowboarder

**1998** snowboarding makes its debut at the Winter Olympics in Nagano, Japan

**1990** The International Snowboard Federation (ISF) is founded and by that time most major ski areas have separate slopes for snowboarders

**1985** the first World Cup in snowboarding is held in Zürs, Austria

**1970s** meanwhile, only 7% of the ski areas even allow snowboarding

**1970s** subsequent entrepreneurs come up with new designs that slowly develop it into the snowboard as we know it today

**1965** Sherman Poppen of Michigan, US, invents the first modern snowboard, known as the Snurfer
