community center

We renovated an existing church to become the City's Community Center. The facility provides offices for the Parks and Recreation Department, space for public meetings, kitchen facilities, library, lounge, game room, auditorium and craft rooms.

aquatic center

The \$3.8 million innovative Aquatic Park, built on 4 acres, provides recreational facilities for 1,800 people. The family aquatic center includes a lazy river, lap pool, wacky water kiddie pool, 5 slides, a leisure pool, playgrounds, sun decks, bathhouses, pavilion and shade structures.

sportport soccer complex

The Sports Recreational Complex is a 65-acre complex. The sports complex includes 12 grass, lighted fields for soccer, softball, baseball, and rugby. The complex is ringed with jogging trails. The Sports Recreational Complex is the largest soccer and rugby complex in the St. Louis area.

city park

A 6-acre addition to Vago Park includes various amenities such as new pavilions, multi-purpose courts, and extensive landscaping. It also includes the bio-stabilization of a creek bank using a variety of environmental treatments, including gabions, composite revetment, live crib wall, and creek grade control structures.

public works improvements

Concurrent with the public facilities, park and roadway projects, Landmark managed the design and construction of the City's various stormwater system improvements and street and bridge improvements.
