THE VINEYARD STORY

In 1999, Roger Scommegna planted a vineyard on top of Cold Spring Mountain off Signal Ridge Road, 9 miles inland from the Pacific Ocean. Overlooking the picturesque Anderson Valley at an elevation of 2,642 feet, the Signal Ridge Vineyard is the highest altitude vineyard in all of Mendocino, Sonoma and Napa Counties. This challenging terroir produces high end singular fruit.

WINEMAKING & TASTING NOTES

This is the inaugural release of SRV Brut Sparkling wine, made in the méthode traditionnelle. A pale lemon in color, its bubbles crown the rim of each glass like a bracelet of diamonds. It offers aromas of autumn harvest apples and bread dough rising on the hearth. Hints of apple pie and marzipan tarry alongside the crisp minerality that lingers on the palate. Delightful to sip on its own, or paired with a sunset. Cheers!
