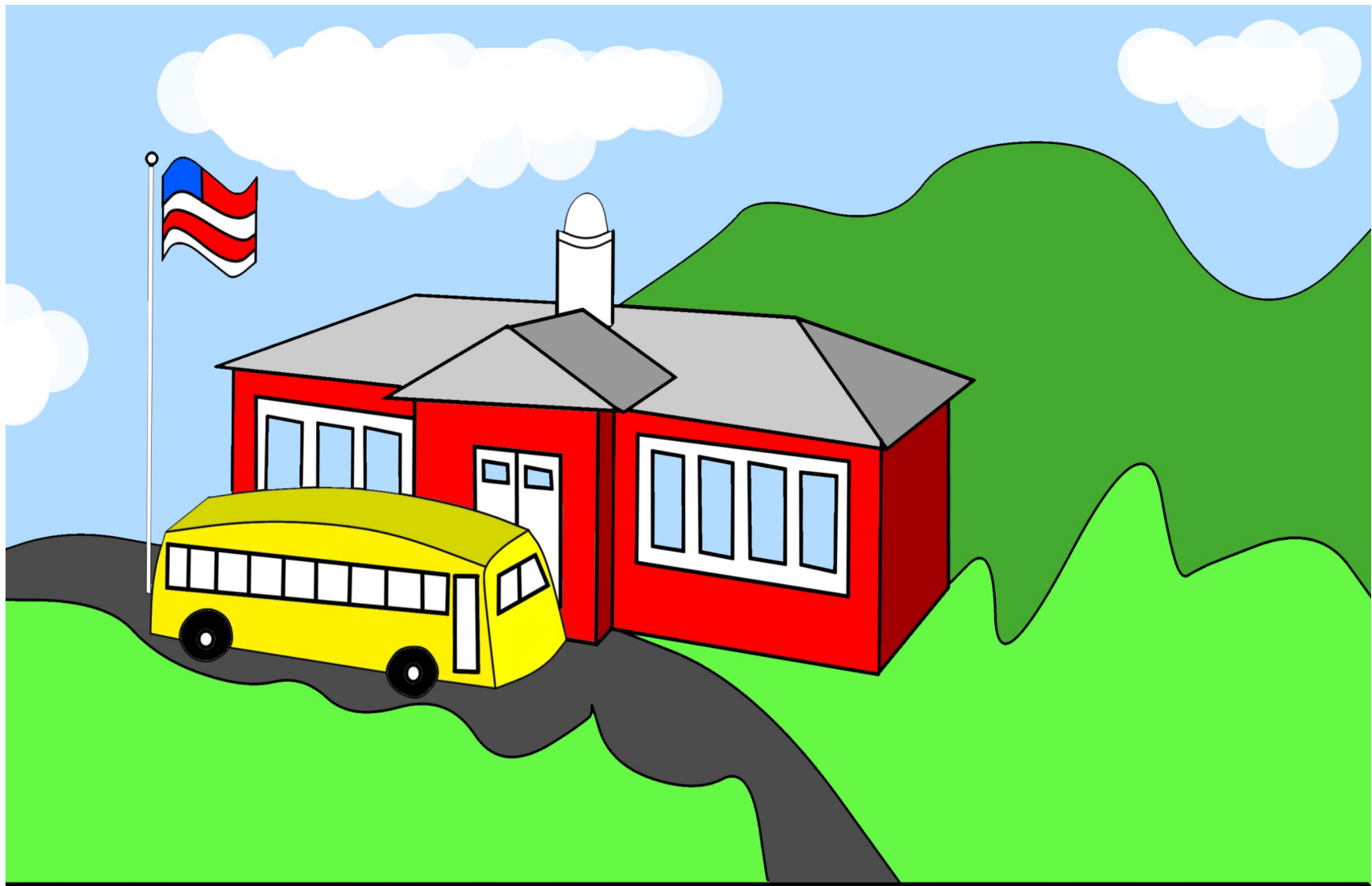

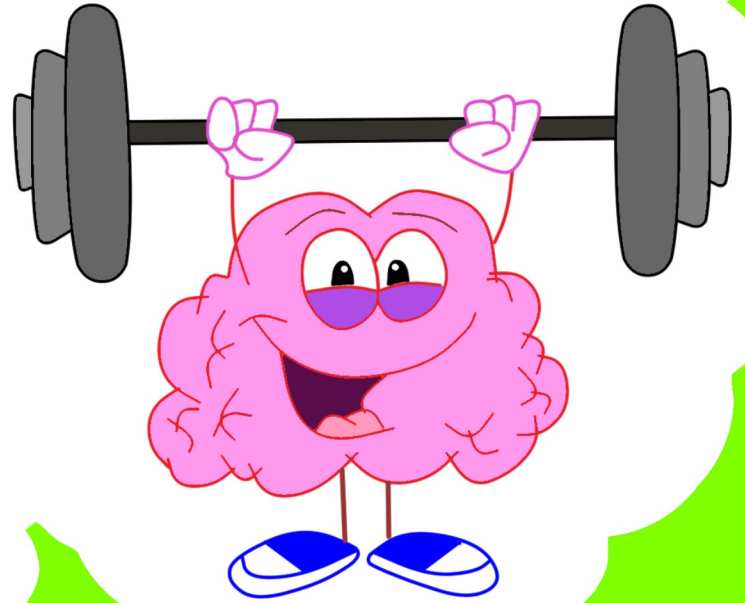


I am always attentive at school.



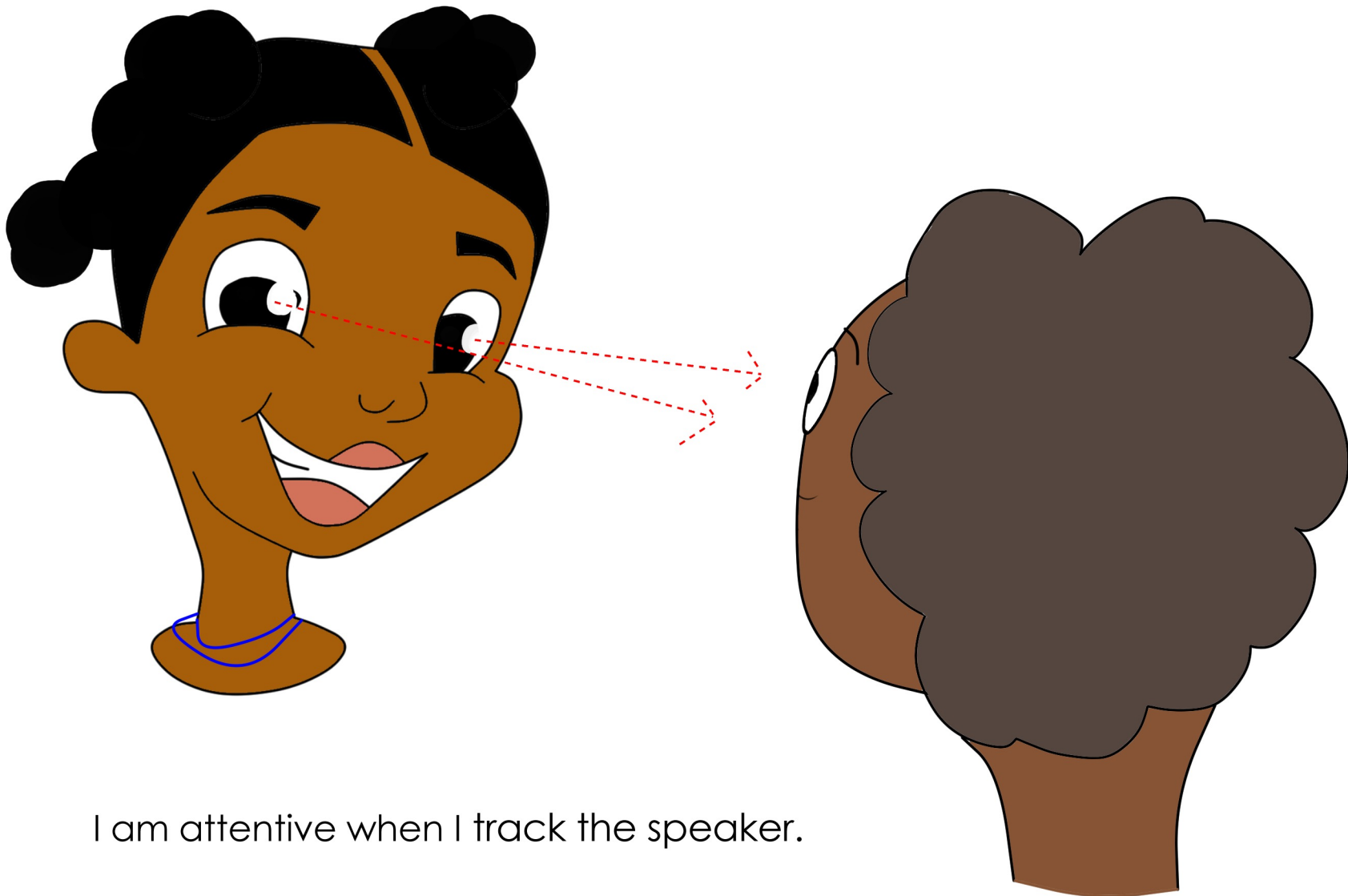
I am attentive at school when I listen carefully and stay focused on what I'm learning.

When I'm attentive at school, my brain can grow to be super strong!





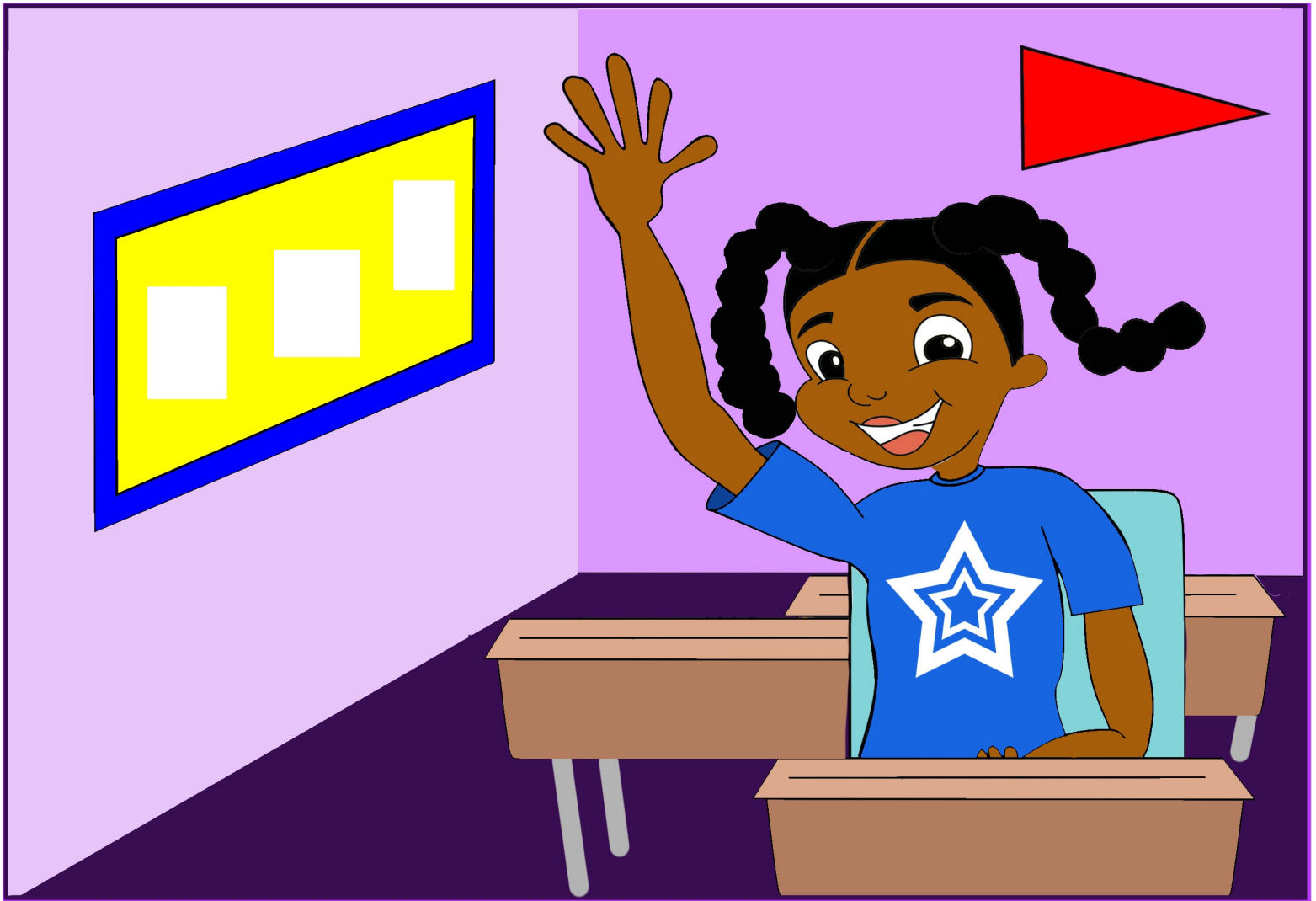
I am attentive at school when I sit up straight on the rug.

I am attentive when I listen closely to my teacher.

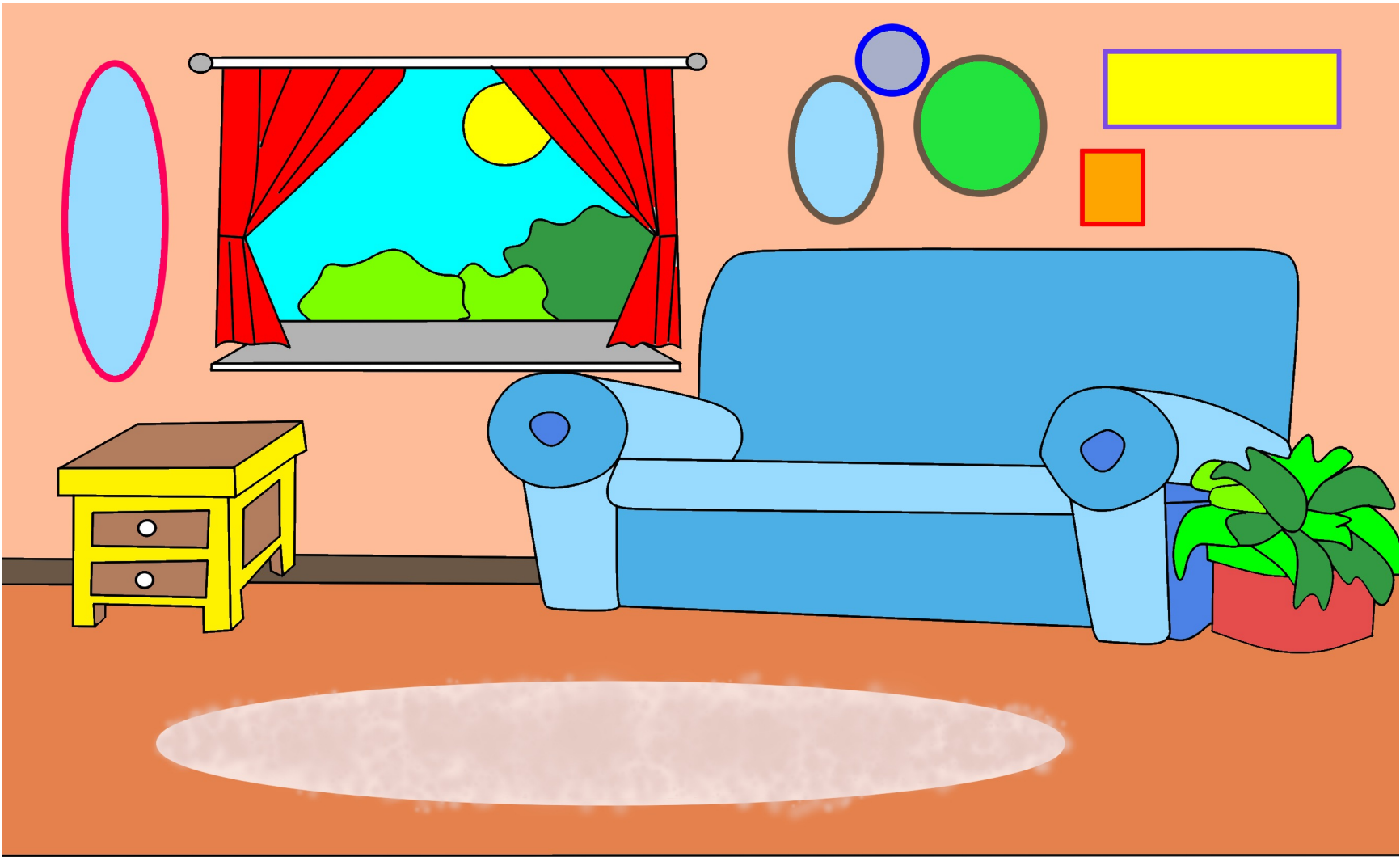


I am attentive when I raise my hand to answer questions.

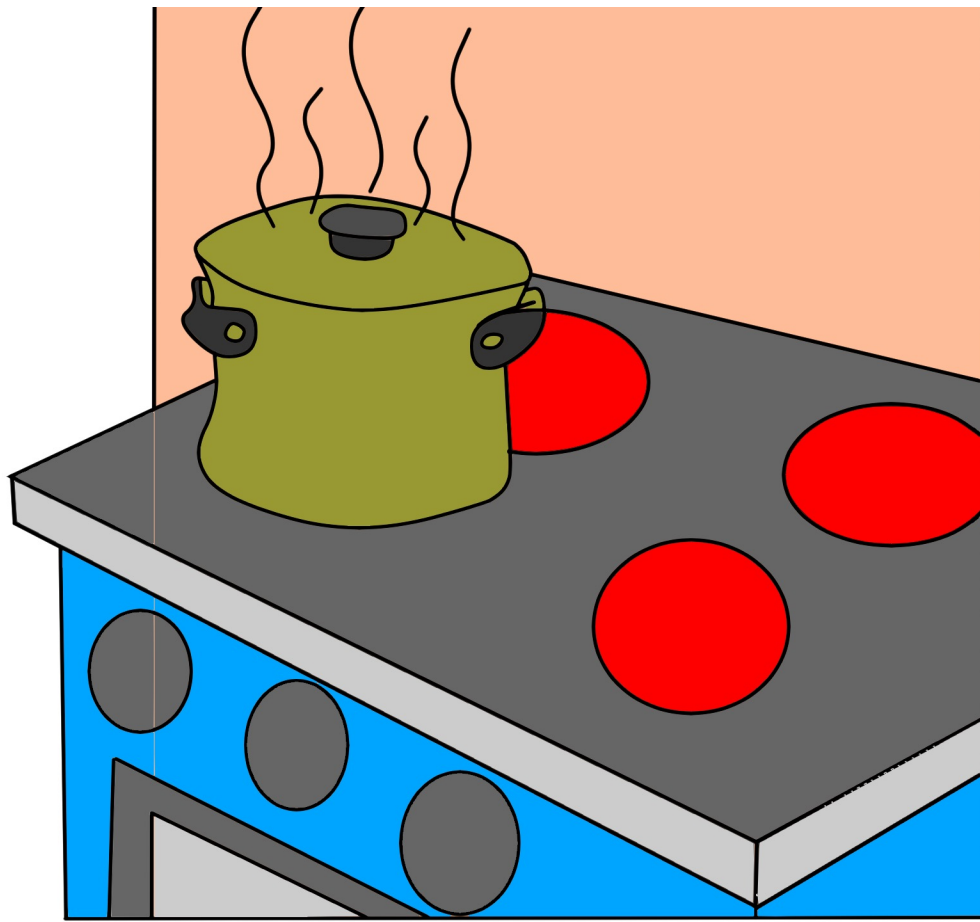
Home



I am attentive at home.



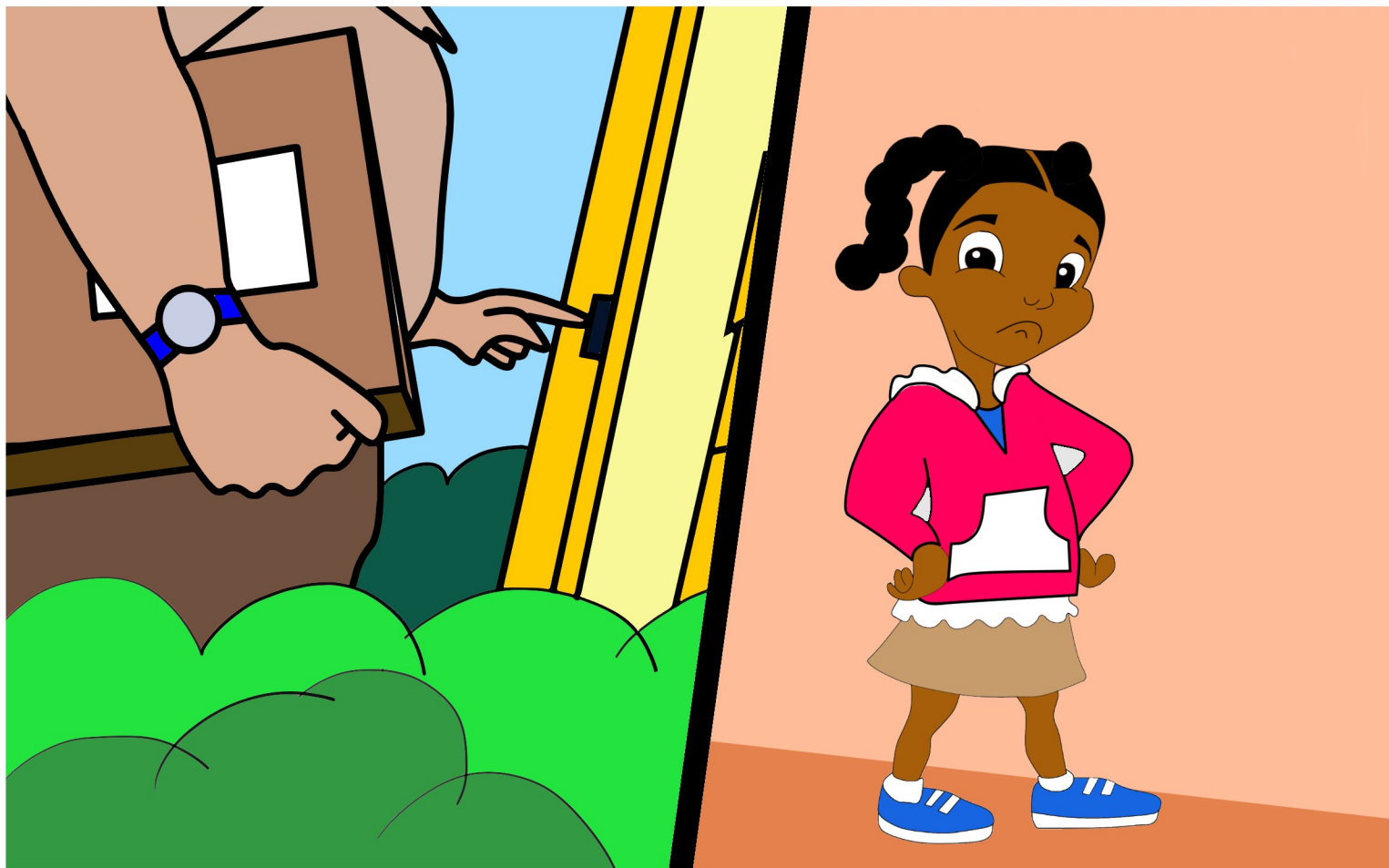
Being attentive at home

I am attentive at home when I follow my mom's directions the first time.

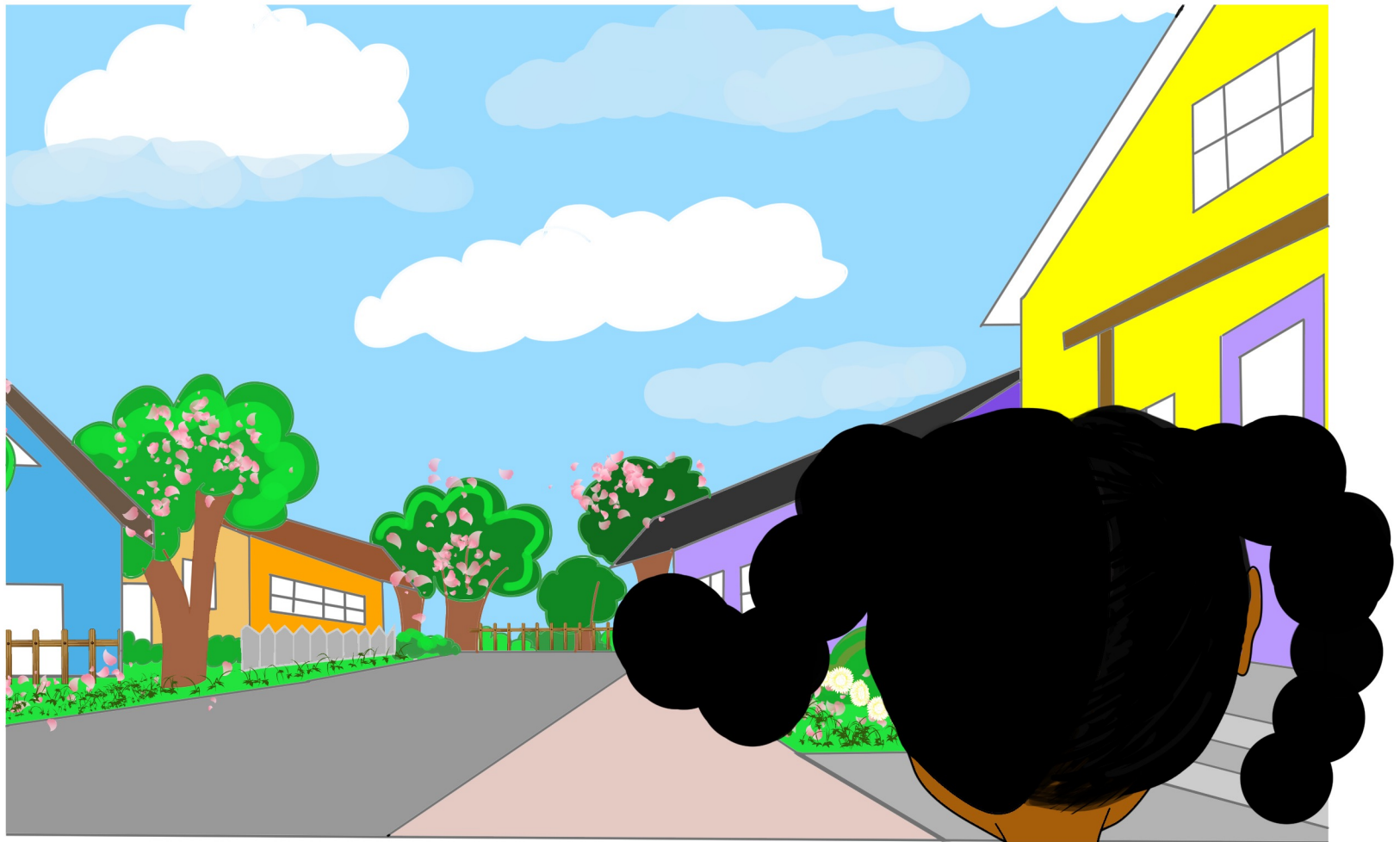
