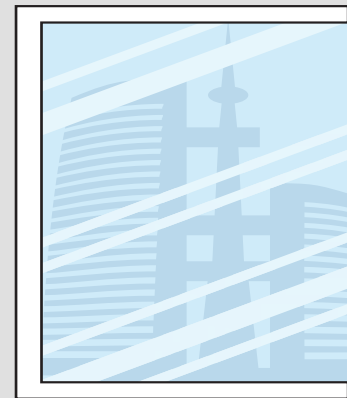
SCHOOL
