Expectations and Responsibilities of Miss Northern Navajo Teen

In the event that you are chosen as the Miss Northern Navajo Teen, your duties will include as follows:

- Miss Northern Navajo Teen candidates must not have been married before, or will not get married during the duration of her reign. Violation of this will result in immediate surrender of the title of Miss Northern Navajo Teen. The title will automatically be reassigned to whoever is 1st Runner up.
- Miss Northern Navajo Teen candidates must not have been pregnant before, or will not become pregnant during the duration of her reign. Violation of this will result in immediate surrender of the title of Miss Northern Navajo Teen and the title will automatically be reassigned to whoever is 1st Runner up.
- Must not be engaged in any sort of relationship with a significant other or cohabitate with a significant other.
- The reign is for one full year (date she received the title until date of the next Miss Northern Navajo Teen)
- Be a positive role model, will be expected to act in an appropriate manner at ALL times throughout the course of the pageant and if chosen throughout the course of her reign.
- She will be expected to dress appropriate and professional at all times, when at events she will be required to wear traditional attire. Crown and sash must be worn the entire day's event. (unless specified by pageant coordinator)
- Responsible for the care of Crown and Sash, and will be expected to return Crown and sash at the end of reign to the next chosen Miss Northern Navajo Teen.
- Represent the Northern Navajo agency, Northern Navajo Nation Fair, and most importantly the Navajo Nation.
- Will be expected to be a motivational speaker, and constant engagement with the community.
- Must be prepared to present a speech or talent of some form at public events.



- Must be able to understand and speak the Navajo language she must be open and responsible for expanding her knowledge throughout her reign.
- Must be willing and open to attend all kinds of events. (Powwows, Song& Dance, Dinners, Receptions, Parades, Graduations etc.)
- She will be responsible for her own transportation to and from scheduled events, unless arranged otherwise.
- Miss Northern Navajo Teen must be sensible in her actions throughout the course of her reign. Any report of misconduct of any form will NOT be tolerated and will be thoroughly investigated by the Northern Navajo Nation Fair Board, Northern Navajo Nation Fair Planning Committee and Pageant Coordinator.
- Mandatory attendance at Northern Navajo Nation Fair Board Meeting and Pageant committee meetings.
- Monthly report of events attended should be submitted to pageant Coordinator the last day of every month.
- Miss Northern Navajo Teen will be expected to present quarterly presentations to the Northern Navajo Nation Fair Board/ Panning committee when requested.
- Miss Northern Navajo Teen will receive \$1000.00 scholarship upon the successful **completion** of her reign as Miss Northern Navajo. If she is unable to complete and fulfill in any way her duty as Miss Northern Navajo, the \$1000.00 scholarship becomes null and void.
- The Northern Navajo Nation Fair Board, Northern Navajo Nation Planning Committee and the Miss Northern Navajo Pageant Committee and Coordinator reserve the right to terminate Miss Northern Navajo due to ANY kind of misconduct.
- Miss Northern Navajo Teen must agree to the expected behavior and responsibilities of Miss Northern Navajo prior to the pageant. The Northern Navajo Nation Fair Board/ Planning committees and Miss Northern Navajo Pageant Coordinator has full authority in making final decisions regarding Miss Northern Navajo.



By signing this contract you agree that:

- I. You agree to follow ALL Miss Northern Navajo Teen policy and procedures during the pageant and throughout the duration of her reign.
- II. That you dismiss and release any responsibility for loss, injury, accident, theft, or damage to contestant or property from the Northern Navajo Nation Fair Board, Northern Navajo Nation Planning Committee, Miss Northern Navajo/ Teen Pageant Coordinator/ Committee and the Phil Thomas Performing Arts Center.
- III. Understand that ANY violation of any policies may result in disqualification from pageant or dismissal from the title of Miss Northern Navajo title.

Policies and Procedures

1. All contestants must be of good moral character and must not exhibit careless behavior.
2. Contestant shall not have a criminal record or have been convicted of a crime (felony).
3. Contestants will conduct themselves in a courteous and professional manner at all times, this includes family members.
4. Contestants must not and will not defame the pageant organization, Northern Navajo Nation Fair Board, Northern Navajo Nation Fair Committee, other participating contestants, the pageant coordinator and or committee, through any action at all: whether it is oral, written and including any statements or remarks displayed on the internet through social media sites. (Facebook, myspace, Instagram, etc) Shall a contestant defame any of the above during or after she will be prohibited in participating in the pageant as well as future Miss Northern Navajo/ Teen Pageant. Shall she receive the title of Miss Northern Navajo/ Teen; she will be terminated from her title.
5. During the pageant or any activities surround the pageant there shall be no use of illegal; drugs, tobacco, or alcohol.
6. The pageant committee expects each contestant to display the highest degree of sportsmanship during the pageant.
7. Each contestant should be mindful that they are representing themselves, their family, and their community.
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct of any sort from contestants and/ or Family members could result in the disqualification and affect future eligibility to compete for Miss Northern Navajo/ Teen Pageant.
9. Contestant must be present at all required competitions and activities related to the pageant.
10. Contestants must arrive on time and fully dressed 30 minutes prior to each competition round
11. All contestants must be ready and dressed for their competition, along with sashes and numbers.



12. Contestants will provide their own transportation and lodging to and from the pageant activities.
13. A pageant judge must not be approached by a contestant or a contestant's family member with the intent to influence or harass. Action of this type can and will result in disqualification of the contestant at the discretion of the pageant committee and the coordinator.
14. Decisions of the judges will be final and all scores will be kept confidential.
15. Only contestants, pageant committee helpers, PTAC workers are to be allowed in backstage area. All others are prohibited and will only be allowed to enter with an ID badge.
