"FINDING AIDS FOR CHURCH RECORDS"

This compilation of available microfilms for Catholic and a few Presbyterian churches – from the Archdiocese of Santa Fe (AASF) and the LDS Family History Library (FHL) – is organized by County and then alphabetically by city/town. Within each listing are the churches with whatever records they had and were filmed. At the end of the New Mexico's section is the Diligencias Matrimoniales (also known as the marriage prenuptial investigations).

If you have a location but not sure of the county, click on <u>Cities and Towns</u> to help you locate the right county. Cities and towns also changed names, and this table will identify that information.

Click on <u>Counties in New Mexico</u> to find out more about when each was established. New Mexico started with 8 counties in 1852 and now has 33.

Also provided are additional tips to help with your research and where else to look for records. Keep in mind that churches were not located in every city/town, and priests often traveled to varied locations. These mission churches are often located near Pueblos, but this does not mean your ancestor was Native American, it is only the church they used.

Migration in New Mexico happened all the time. Keep in mind that after 1803 there was a huge migration eastward. When researching families that moved, you must go from where they left to where they went, and keep going back and forth. For instance, if you find them in Anton Chico, ask yourself where did they come from?

<u>Note</u>: While all listings contain FHL films, not all dioceses have film numbers; they've not been released for public use. That's why you'll see AASF as a column only in those counties which fall under the jurisdiction of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. The others – the Dioceses of Las Cruces, Gallup, El Paso, Texas and Pueblo, Colorado – will not have this column in their section.
