US dentist Walter Palmer 'regrets' killing Zimbabwe lion Cecil

A US dentist who kill a lion in Zimbabwe says he regrets shooting the well-known animal and he insists he would not have shot Cecil if he had known that it was an illegal hunt.

Police in Zimbabwe have arrested two people over the death of Cecil, the country's most famous lion, and say Mr Palmer may also face poaching charges.

But Mr Palmer, from Minnesota, said he relied on professional guides to find a lion and obtain the necessary permits, she went on to add, 'If I had had more local knowledge, I might have discovered that the permit was illegal.
