Nonsectarian and nonpartisan, the American Task Force for Lebanon (ATFL) is a nonprofit, tax-exempt organization of prominent Americans of Lebanese heritage, who advocate for the strengthening of the historic U.S.-Lebanon relationship. The mission and objectives of ATFL shall always be in the best interest of the United States, and will promote the national unity, independence, and prosperity of a democratic and multisectarian Lebanon.

Priorities

The ATFL board has specified three priorities for Lebanon and the U.S.-Lebanon relationship:

- **support for the Lebanese Armed Forces and security services**
- **broadening Lebanon's capacity to cope with the enormous numbers of Syrian refugees**
- **protecting vulnerable Middle East religious communities**

ATFL mobilizes its access to senior U.S. and Lebanese government officials, Congress, and the Congressional Caucus on U.S.-Lebanon Relations, toward these priorities. ATFL advocacy has helped result in \$1.3 billion in overall U.S. security assistance for Lebanon since 2007 and \$964.5 million in U.S. assistance for the Syrian refugees in Lebanon and the Lebanese host communities since 2012.
