LERA Partner Elected New President of SEAoNY

Currently, he is responsible for the oversight and coordination of several ongoing healthcare and adaptive reuse projects, including at the NYU Langone Medical Center, for which he is developing and managing the design of new facilities, extensive renovations and the construction of a new tower as part of the state-of-the-art Helen L. and Martin S. Kimmel Pavilion.

"I'm honored and eager to lead the chapter through some exciting new initiatives," said Mr. González. "SEAoNY is an invaluable resource for structural engineers and a great liaison for the broader design and real estate community."

Mr. González holds a Master of Science in Structural Engineering from Cornell University (Ithaca) and a Bachelor of Civil Engineering from The Cooper Union (New York).
