Stand basic equipment



How to reserve an exhibition space



TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Congrex, on behalf of the FOUNDATION FOR DEVELOPMENT OF CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENTAL AGRICULTURE has complied to inform commercial companies about the conditions for participating in the International Congress on Controlled Environment Agriculture, to be held from May 20th to 22nd, 2015, at the Sheraton Hotel in Panama City- Panama.

- 1. The commercial companies must promptly comply with the payments specified in the budget, in order to ensure their participation in the event. In the case of not receiving the down payments on the payment dates set, Congrex, may increase the cost or release the selected space, depending on the case.
- 2. In the case 100% of budgeted item is not paid, Congrex will have the right to not allow the sponsor to enforce it.

 3. The FOUNDATION FOR DEVELOPMENT OF CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENTAL AGRICULTURE reserves the right to sanction, with the partial or full payment of the amount budgeted for the event, or with any other penalty that the FOUNDATION FOR DEVELOPMENT OF CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENTAL AGRICULTURE may deem as appropriate, the company for withdrawing after the reservation of

any commercial space, scientific and / or some other sponsorship has been made.

- Penalty of 100% of the cost of their participation if the withdrawal is formalized 30 calendar days before the event.
- Penalty of 50% of the cost of their participation if the withdrawal is formalized between 31 and 60 calendar days before the event.
 Penalty of 30% of the cost of their participation if formalizes the withdrawal takes place after the signing of this agreement.
 5. All commercial companies should have an insurance policy covering the cost of equipment in case any accident occurs. In the case of the loss of any material and / or equipment, Congrex, as organizer, will not assume any responsibility for their replacement or repair.
- 6. Congrex will supply the Exhibitor's Manual, forty-five (45) days prior to the installation. This document details the dates and installation / dismantling, general regulations for exhibitors, as well as internal regulations of the convention center used as venue. 7. It is not permitted to sub lease, or divide the reserved physical space; only one (1) company will be allowed in reserved space. 8. Congrex reserves the right to market all the physical spaces inside the place where the event will take place, any additional areas wished to be used for advertising and additional promotional space specified in this budget, must be contracted through Congrex; under the economic terms and conditions established by it.

9. All social, scientific and parallel trade is strictly prohibited within the premises of the event during the time it takes place, without permission of the Organizing Committee. E.g. Hospitality Suites, off-site tours, symposia off the venue's site, among others.
