In our Intermediate Session you will be building on what you have learned from the Beginner Session. We will move on to larger projects. You will learn about the basic bag structure, additional stitching & finishing techniques, and construction techniques.

MATERIALS

Including but not limited to pattern paper, leather, card board, snaps, zippers, foam.

TOOLS

All tools needed to complete projects will be provided by Amblard Leather Atelier.

Including but not limited to rulers, straight edges, cutting knife, glue, compass, pricking iron, mallet, sharp awl, round awl, sewing clamp, hammers, edge dye, bee's wax, burnishing iron, wax cloth.
