OVERVIEW

In this class, you will be introduced to working with leather purely by hand. You will learn about the essential tools you will need to work with leather, patternmaking using the symmetry method, assembling small accessories, and finishing.

MATERIALS

All materials needed to complete projects will be provided by Amblard Leather Atelier.

Including but not limited to pattern paper, leather, card board, snaps, zippers, foam.

TOOLS

All tools needed to complete projects will be provided by Amblard Leather Atelier.

Including but not limited to rulers, straight edges, cutting knife, glue, compass, pricking iron, mallet, sharp awl, round awl, sewing clamp, hammers, edge dye, bee's wax, burnishing iron, wax cloth.

Student tool orders are placed once a session approximately the 6th week of the session, please look out for the email via Constant Contact.

Please note it takes 2-3 months to receive French ordered tools. Individual orders will not be placed until full payment is received.

** Please note that all sessions consist of a specific sequence of projects that teach different progressing construction methods.

** Each student works at their own pace. The number of projects created by the end of each session will depend solely on the individual. You may or may not complete all projects.
