This business will also empower individuals with the skills and resources necessary to become sales agents and distributors within their communities. The aim of this new business is to improve accessibility and affordability of products in communities across the Kilimanjaro Region, through a sustainable business model supported by a decentralised distribution network of micro-entrepreneurs.

The Last Mile Training Facilitator will responsible for learning and developing the Last Mile curriculum and delivering training sessions to a growing network of sales women. The curriculum covers many health related topics, product knowledge and sales strategies relevant to low and middle income consumers. Due to the nature of this position, female candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.

About Anza

Big Vision

Every low and middle income family in Tanzania has the opportunity to improve their livelihoods through the access to appropriate products and services provided by a network of social businesses.

Core Purpose

To start and scale social businesses based on the identified needs of the Kilimanjaro Region in Tanzania. We do this in three ways: (1) incubate in-house Anza enterprises; (2) support local entrepreneurs and ideas; (3) bring proven social business models into the region.

You will be responsible for

- Conducting three-week long training sessions with community sales agents, utilizing a variety of participatory training techniques
- Developing and conducting monthly follow-up trainings to review past material and introduce new material
- Recruiting, interviewing and selecting candidates for the Last Mile program
- Maintaining consistent communication and support to a growing network of sales agents, including field visits
- Developing marketing materials including promotional offers



- Receiving training from the developer of the training curriculum and product trainings from product suppliers
- Communicating with District & Ward and other local government officials, supplier representatives, and partner organizations
- Assisting in the monitoring and evaluation of this social business

Selection Criteria

Essential:

- 1. 5 years' experience in sales
- 2. Experience developing and facilitating workshops and training
- 3. Experience in health is an asset
- 4. Fluent written and oral communication skills in both English and Swahili
- 5. Strong interest in social impact and community development
- 6. Comfortable discussing and training on a wide range of topics including feminine health and hygiene, maternal and child health, nutrition, HIV and other health-related topics
