### Biography



Sarah Monzani is an Oscar-winning movie make-up artist whose talent has great depth and range, transforming the likes of Kevin Kline through fifty years of ageing in *De-Lovely* and Madonna into Eva Peron for *Evita*. She has also teamed up with Max Factor to share make-up tips and techniques.

Over the last 20 years, Sarah has captivated audiences with not only the beautiful, but amazing and memorable looks that she has created for the stars of dozens of acclaimed Hollywood films, including *Valkyrie*, *The Next Best Thing*, *Angela's Ashes*, *Alien*, *Midnight Express*, *Interview with a Vampire*, and *Quest for Fire*, for which she and Michele Burke won the second Oscar given in the make-up category.

Sarah began her make-up artist training with a top television company in the UK, where she learned the basics of colour and application, and during these formative years she mastered identification of appropriate make-up styles and creation of stunning images. Her big break into movies came when she worked on *Bugsy Malone*, directed by Alan Parker, and following that, she went on to do bigger films with Parker, including *Midnight Express* and *Evita*. More recently Sarah has worked on *The Life of David Gale* with Laura Linney, *(Cole) De-Lovely* with Kevin Kline and *The Dark* with Sean Bean.

While working on movies, Sarah builds good relationships with directors, cast and crew members and is often requested by the stars with whom she works to do their make-up for personal appearances and photo sessions.

Sarah lives outside London and when not on location is often found working in her garden.
