

AMERICAN DIABETES MONTH

- **Symptoms Include:** urinating often, feeling very thirsty, extreme hunger, unexplained weight loss, extreme fatigue, blurry vision, sores that are slow to heal, very dry skin, tingling or numbness in hands and feet.
- Type 1 Diabetes: is usually diagnosed in children and young adults. The body does not produce insulin in this type.
- Type 2 Diabetes: is the most common type. The body does not use insulin properly, called insulin resistance.
- **Gestational Diabetes:** is a type of diabetes that only pregnant women get. If not treated, it can cause problems for mothers and babies.
- Treatment: Healthy eating, physical activity, insulin injections, or blood glucose testing.
