## **NATIONAL BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH**

- 1 in 8 U.S. women will be diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetime.
- Breast cancer is the second most common kind of cancer in women.
- Breast cancer is the second leading cause of death among women.
- If detected early, the survival rate is 98%.
- Women ages 20 to 39 should receive a clinical breast exam every 3 years.
- Women ages 40 to 49 should get a mammogram every year.
- Women ages 50 to 74, should get a mammogram every 2 years.
