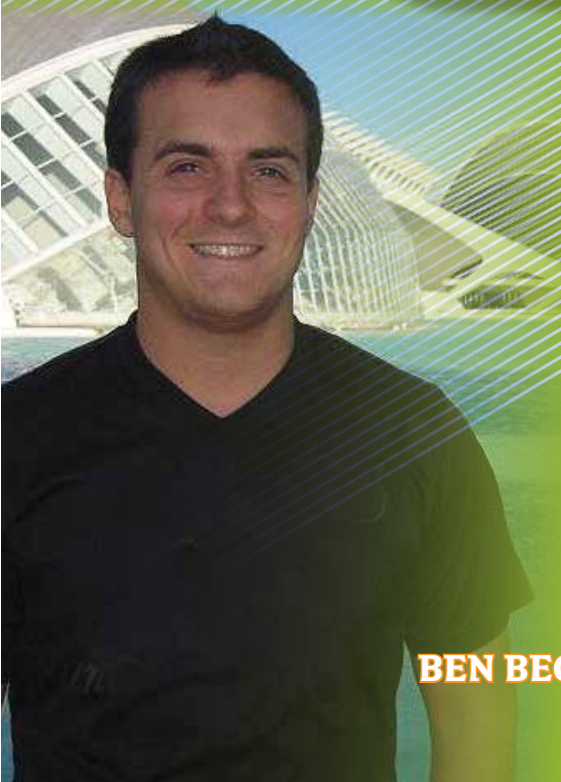

# Dear Friends,

As we write this the new academic year is starting. It is a very exciting time for Cleveland Hillel as each of our four program divisions are growing. We are developing more avenues for Jewish undergraduate, graduate, and professional students and their peers to meet one another, grow as young Jews committed to their people and their fellow man as they create a dynamic community. Students have taught us that they are passionate about Jewish life, and that their interests include both traditional ways of connecting as well as innovative ones.

Case Western Reserve University is welcoming its most diverse, best educated and largest incoming freshman class. Hillel too is welcoming its largest number of Jewish undergraduate students on campus in many years. Last year, we wrote about partnering with CWRU to strengthen a Jewish presence on campus. This year we can report that our hard work has paid off. Our halls and offices have been filled with students and parents looking at, listening to and learning about what Hillel has to offer.

As you will see, we have a lot to offer:

- Last year the total number of students attending all Hillel events including Shabbat & holiday dinners, Israel advocacy, education, leadership development and social programs increased by 15%. We expect this number to continue to grow this year.
- The **Summer Internship Program**, an 8-week paid internship and immersion program for undergrads, celebrated its fifth year. Internship placements grew by fifty percent this year as we placed 60 interns at a wide variety of businesses and non-profits. We are proud that we placed our first intern at a local Fortune 500 company.
- **JCLE**, our graduate and post grad initiative for 21-29 year old adults, continues to attract hundreds of Jewish singles and young couples to the "hottest" spots in Cleveland.
- **Graduate students** connected with professionals working in the community. Students in the health fields met with professionals in their fields at an exhibit focused on the science of fear. A mentoring program was established for law students with area lawyers.

We want to take this opportunity to thank our donors and supporters for all you have done to enable Jewish life to thrive on campus. Please join us to help ensure a stronger, educated and experienced Jewish community on campus and throughout the world.

What's happening on the other 10 campuses where we work?

- **Oberlin College** continues to produce unique and outstanding programming for its large and diverse Jewish student body.
- Programming at **Cleveland State University** has doubled in the last year.
- **John Carroll University** welcomed a new Hillel chapter onto campus.
- Jewish life for students on Cleveland area campuses is more accessible than ever through our use of social media.

What are our goals for the 2012-13 academic year?

We intend to build upon our successes by focusing on our core values, offering students the opportunity to develop their unique Jewish journey while being part of a community. We do this through Israel programming, Shabbat and holiday celebrations, Jewish learning, Social Justice initiatives and leadership development opportunities. Our largest weekly program is our ultra-popular Kasher Friday night Shabbat dinners. We can't wait to add all of our new students. We will be bursting at the seams with pride!
