Are you hoping to be closer in touch with your own inner wisdom and guidance? And to do it in an easy, almost magical way? SoulCollage® is an exciting and powerful process of working with visual images (cutting and pasting from printed photos--no particular skill, artistic ability or experience needed) and then using the cards to access information from your own inner self. You develop both intuition and personal imagery by creating cards that function as a personal "deck" that can be used as tools for individual exploration.) The card-making is satisfying and fun (it is addictive!)—and it is a discovery in itself—but it's only the first part; then you learn to do "readings," to explore what the cards you created have to "say." The process is direct and delightful: certain images call to us and show us what they want us to know, and the readings take us to our deepest level of wisdom.
