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**ARTICLE 4. MEMBERSHIP:**

Section 4.1. Membership, Annual dues and Renewal:

A natural person may become a member of the organization by completing the following:

- a. Paying the annual membership fee of \$11.00 and
- b. Completing an application form provided by the organization. Youth below the age 18 are considering as member without annual requirement dues.

Section 4.2. Limitations:

An individual below age Eighteen (18) has NO right to cast vote, and NO rights be elected as governing bodies unless they reach 18 years and older. They need to register and paid dues to be member after Eighteen (18) years old.

Section 4.3. Honorary members are identified and membership granted by majority vote or consensus of the Board.

Section 4.4. Renewal:

Membership, between 18 and 65 years is subject to renewal annually with \$11.00 renewal fees. Community members above 65 years old, or (with disability conditions any age category, provisioned by article 4.2., all SSI beneficiaries), are subject to have NO renewal fees.

Section 4.5. Rights:

- a. Voting: Each member in good standing shall be entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote of the members.
- b. Participation: Take active part in the programs and activities of the Association.
- c. Be elected to the governing bodies of the association provisioned by article 4.1 and 4.2.
- d. Receive information and provide feedbacks on all aspects of the Association's activities.

Section 4.6. Responsibilities:

A member of the Association shall have the responsibilities to:

- a. Belong to and take an active part in the activities of the Association.
- b. Take necessary steps to understand, carry out, and uphold the mission, aims and objectives, principles, policies and programs of the Association.
- c. Explain the mission, aims and objectives, principles, policies and programs of the Association to other people whenever necessary.
- d. Develop an insight into the social, cultural, political and economic problems facing the Association membership.
- e. Advocate against all forms of racism, ethnic cleansing, religious, cultural and political segregation or any other form of discrimination.
- f. Observe discipline, integrity, honesty and loyalty while working for the Association at all times.
- g. Refrain from engaging in activities against the Association.
- h. Pay the applicable membership dues as fixed by the Board on time.

Section 4. 7. Resignation:

Any member may resign by filing a written resignation with the secretary, but such resignation shall not relieve the member so resigning of the obligation to pay any dues, assessments, or other charges accrued and unpaid.
