I also agree to participate in the National Festival Float Parade on **Saturday, 12**th **November, 2016** at 3:00pm with an on time arrival for 2:15pm.

RULES AND JUDGING CRITERIA

1. Eligibility

Failure to comply with the below eligibility criteria will result in disqualification.

- a) For the purposes of the competition each contestant must:
 - Be Caymanian by birth or status holder
 - Have reached the age of 16 by January 1st of the competition year
 - Submit the required form by the deadline of 14th October, 2016
 - Reside in the district in which she is representing

2. Costumes

- Costumes are recommended not to exceed ten (10) pounds in weight
- Costumes should not exceed five (5) feet in height (from the top of shoulders) or width (from the wrist)
- Costumes must reflect the 2016 Pirates Week theme: "Age of Romance"
- Costumes previously shown or "ready-made" will not be accepted



- Each contestant is encouraged to acquire the music that best suits her stage presentation
- Each contestant is responsible for costs of her make-up and hair on event date

4. Judging Criteria

- a) Scores will be tallied by an independent accounting and auditing firm Smith & Tempral.
- b) Each contestant will have a maximum of three (3) minutes on stage during the individual presentation
- c) Each contestant shall be awarded a maximum of 100 points in each category (below) with a total maximum of 300 points. The contestants with the highest number of points wins with the next highest receiving Runner up and so on;
 - <u>Costume authenticity</u> (30 points) Original design, design execution and ingenuity, (all body parts must be covered appropriately)
 - <u>Presentation (20 points)</u> Stage presentation, audience engagement, movement, use of cloth/accessories
 - <u>Use of Caymanian products</u> (20 points) Thatch/Shell appliqués, French puffs, wompers, thatch bags, Cayman symbols etc.
 - Detail (15 points) Hats, gloves, shoes, jewelry and other appropriate accessories
 - Relevance of PWF theme (15 points) Costume must reflect the 2016 Pirates Week theme: "Age of Romance"
- d) Each contestant shall be awarded a total maximum of 10 points in the *Most Ingenuitive* category (this category is judged separately and does not affect the contestants overall score)







5. Judges

- a) Three judges will make up the adjudication panel
- b) Judges shall have the sole authority and discretion of the selection of winners; with the exception of the *People's Choice Award* which will be chosen by the crowd/audience
- c) Judges will be chosen by the Pirates Week Festival Staff and event sponsor/s and will be announced/introduced on the night of the event

6. Awards

- a) Awards will be presented for:
 - First Place/Winner will receive a trophy, crown, sash and \$500 cash prize
 - Second Place/Runner Up will receive a trophy and \$300 cash prize
 - Third Place/2nd Runner Up will receive a trophy and \$100 cash prize
 - Most Ingenuitive will receive a trophy
 - People's Choice will receive a trophy
 - Participant trophy will be given to all contestants
- b) People's Choice will be chosen on the night of the event by an audience poll.

RULES FOR THE WINNER

- The Cayman Islands Festival Queen shall be deemed Queen for a year and will crown and sash their successor (with the exception of unforeseen absence).
- 2. The Cayman Islands Festival Queen shall be required to participate (wearing the winning costume) at the following:
 - Pirates Week Festival Float Parade
 - District Heritage Day events for the district in which she represents
- Though not required, all other contestants are encouraged to accompany her in the Parade.
 A vehicle/ float will be provided by the Pirates Week Office for the Festival Queen and Runner Up winners.
- 4. The Cayman Islands Festival Queen may be required to make appearances from time to time in official capacities (as needed).

CONDITIONS FOR DISQUALIFICATION

- 1. The Pirates Week Festival reserves the right to disqualify any contestant at any time during the contest without publicising its reason/s.
- 2. If the Festival Queen title holder, during their reign, is found to have committed a breach of these rules or should be involved in any act or conduct which the organisers deems unlawful, inappropriate or tarnishes the image of the festival; the title will be forfeited.
- 3. In the event of a forfeiture of the title from the current title holder, the organisers may confer the title upon the Runner-up in the contest.
