## **Who is a CIT?**

Counselors in Training, at ACA, are young teens who want to build leadership skills, are ready for more in-depth studio art experience, and who enjoy working with kids.

## **What do CITs do every day?**

In the morning CITs receive leadership training and get to know their group. CITs are assigned to a class in art, music, or drama, for one period each day, to help with younger children and gain mentoring skills. They have teacher led art instruction, learn cooperative games, and create challenging group projects.

## **What's special about this program?**

Each week CITs take field trips to enhance their learning. We'll visit local museums, galleries, public art, and artist studios. In their art class, CITs work on

challenging and fun projects in a variety of media, with the emphasis on creativity and exploration.

## **Are CITs hired for counselor positions?**

Counselors are hired at age 16 or older, on a space-available basis, for individuals who meet our high standards. While being a CIT does not automatically assure that you will get a counselor position should you apply, it definitely increases your chances. Read about our new Assistant Counselor program on Page 14.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## *What should I bring?*

For all our programs, please send your child in clothes you don't mind getting a bit messy. No flip flops, please. For Young at Art and Teen Studio, please send a **nut-free** snack and a water bottle with your child's first and last name. For Vacation Arts Camp, Drama Camp and CIT, please send a **nut-free** snack, a **nut-free** lunch, and a water bottle with your child's first and last name. For Extended Day, please send an additional nut-free snack. Your child might also like to bring a book for quiet time during Extended Day. **Please leave valuables at home.** Cell phones and other electronics may not be used during camp hours.

## *Will my child be with other kids of the same age? Can I make a special friend request?*

Campers will spend each week in small groups of approximately 15 kids. Groups are decided based upon each camper's age. Each group enjoys activities that are specifically designed to be age appropriate. Please submit all friend requests when you register and we will do our best to honor these requests.

## *Do the kids get outdoors and have any physical activity during the day?*

Our full-day campers enjoy a good amount of physical activity and outdoor time – it's summer after all! After our first art activity, we have a 30 minute snack break outside with supervised free play time. After lunch, we have an outdoor free play time - on the playground, on the ball court, or in organized outdoor activities and games. Also, during our drama and music activities, campers are constantly on the move, playing group drama games, learning fun dances and moving to music.

## *How do I sign up for Extended Day?*

## *My child loves art, but is afraid of drama – what can we do?*

Our camp program integrates all of the arts – visual arts, music and drama, but no child is ever forced to participate in activities that feel uncomfortable. Kids who do not want to get on stage can help with props or costumes, or find another way to take part in our drama activities. Most often, though, our shy or reluctant campers enjoy our drama games so much they that forget their fears and enjoy the experience.

## *How will I know what my child is doing in camp each week?*

Before the start of each weekly session, you will receive a welcome email from our Education Manager, outlining our projects and activities for the week. On Thursday of each week, you will receive our camp e-news with a slideshow of the campers in action. We strive to get a photo of every camper if we can! On Friday of each week, we present an Open House at 4:00 pm, where campers display their art projects and each group performs a short song or skit on stage.

## *What forms and paperwork do I need to submit?*

Please visit the Arts Camp page on our website, **acarts.org**, where you will find our Emergency Contact and Medical Forms and Allergy Action Plan (if needed). In addition, we require a copy of your child's most recent immunization record. **These forms are due no later than two weeks prior to the start of the program.**

# ASSISTANT COUNSELOR

**ACA is pleased to introduce our new Assistant Counselor Program!**

Assistant Counselors are teens in grades 9 or 10 who want to acquire professional experience with the support and guidance of an ACA staff member as they grow into the role of an Arts Camp Counselor. Assistant Counselors receive daily assignments, which involve assisting campers in their activities and supporting the roles of the teachers and counselors. The Assistant Counselor program runs all 11 weeks of Vacation Arts camp. You may work one or more works as an Assistant Counselor.

**HOURS:** Monday – Friday,  
9:00 am – 4:30 pm

- For older teens who want to work at ACA.
- Assistant Counselors receive daily assignments to assist in different roles at Vacation Arts Camp
- Daily “Staff Meetings” to discuss challenges, victories and get training in topics like health & safety and child development
- A small number of Assistant Counselors each week means individualized instruction and lots of hands-on assistance
- Weekly stipend as well as community service hours

## Assistant Counselor FAQ

### What is the difference between Counselors in Training and Assistant Counselors?

Both the CIT and Assistant Counselor programs offer teens the opportunity to acquire valuable leadership skills and facilitate classroom activities for younger campers; however, the expectations for participants in these two groups are very different. CITs are the oldest group of campers and their program emphasizes social experiences, art-making and mentoring skills. Assistant Counselors are part of the ACA summer staff and we expect the same level of responsibility, professionalism, punctuality and reliability that we see in the rest of our summer staff. Assistant Counselors need not have been CITs previously!

### Will Assistant Counselors be hired as Camp Counselors for future programs?

Assistant Counselors who have demonstrated the necessary skills may apply to work as Camp Counselors for future camp weeks. It is our hope that Assistant Counselors will be fully prepared to step into the role of Camp Counselor!

### How to Apply:

Assistant Counselors must apply for the position. We are looking students entering 9th and 10th grade who love the arts, enjoy working with kids and want leadership and professional training! If that sounds good to you, download the application at **acarts.org** and return it to us as soon as possible.

### What do Assistant Counselors do each day?

Assistant Counselors check in with an ACA staff member to receive daily assignments each morning. They spend most of the day assisting campers and attend a daily staff meeting in the afternoon to receive training and discuss what they are learning in the camp. Assistant Counselors take two half hour breaks each day.

### Arts Camp Counselors:

ACA is seeking mature, responsible and reliable college and high school students who like working with kids, have an outgoing personality, and enjoy the visual arts, music and drama.

Counselors lead a group of approximately 15 children in groups divided according to age. Counselors reinforce all safety precautions, model appropriate behavior, aid teachers in carrying out lesson plans, supervise children during snack, lunch, and during all activities. Counselors must be 16 years or older, responsible and mature.
