
The Miteri Recycle Center

The Need :

Remote areas of Nepal like Jumla, Humla, Kalikot, Achham or Dailekh are characterized by the lack of access to economic resources and basic living commodities for the local communities. In the mountains, living conditions are extremes and temperatures may reach -20°C. Cold appears as a lethal threat for poor people who cannot afford warm clothes.

The Solution

Since 2010, the Miteri Recycle Center provides affordable warm clothes to the poorest communities in hardly accessible provinces of Nepal and empower local women to start the own business as Miteri cloth retailers.
