




SPOTLIGHT ON NUMBERS REVENUE AND EXPENSE CHARTS






*This overview reflects an unaudited financial summary for the 12 months period ending December 31, 2014. Our 2014 financial audit is currently in progress and will be made available by request.

SERVICE BREAKDOWN FY 2015 CHART








Both Direct and Secondary Victims are reflected in this data. Direct (or primary) victims are those who directly experience the act of child abuse and/or sexual violence. Secondary victims are the loved ones of the person victimized. Child abuse and sexual violence affect more than just the direct victim – those close to the victim are also traumatized and often require services to cope.







Sexual violence and child abuse cuts across all boundaries. The ethnicity of victims served reflects the general population of the counties we serve.



SPOTLIGHT ON PROGRAMS AND IMPACT

PARENT CAFÉ



In 2015, Hope Haven received a seed grant from the Sisters of Charity Foundation to start a new prevention program

called Parent Café. Parent Cafés engage parents in meaningful conversations about what matters most – their family. Our Parent Cafés are focused on building the five research based protective factors that mitigate the negative impacts of trauma. These five protective factors are: Parental Resilience, Social Connections, Knowledge of Parenting and Child Development, Concrete Support in Times of Need and Social and Emotional Competence of Children. For six week, Parents meet and participate in a facilitated conversation/discussion with other parents. Hope Haven is proud to partner with the Antioch Education Center to implement Parent Café.

Here are the positive results of this program:

- 100% of participants agreed that they learned a new way to handle stress in their life and planned on taking better care of themselves
- 93% of participants reported making positive changes in their family life as a result of being in the program
- 94% of participants reported that they learned about a community resource that can help their family and they are more willing to ask for help
- 96% if participants reported spending more time understanding their children's feelings and emotions.

CHILD AND FAMILY TRAUMATIC STRESS INTERVENTION (CFTSI)

One of the highlights of 2015 is our partnership with Yale University, National Children's Alliance and the Duke Endowment to expand our array of research supported therapies, including one designed to prevent children's long-term distress in the immediate days after abuse happens. The Child and Family Traumatic Stress Intervention (CFTSI) is a brief (5-8 sessions) evidence based early intervention treatment for children ages 3 – 18. This three years partnership will allow three of our Therapists at Hope Haven to be



trained by the experts at Yale University to implement this model of treatment. In our first year, we are already seeing amazing results.

The average pre-treatment trauma scores for the children who received this treatment in 2015 was 27.57 (a score of 15 and higher indicates clinically significant symptoms of PTSD). At the completion of treatment, the average trauma score has dropped to 12.62.

Parents also rate their child's trauma scores before and after treatment. The discrepancy between the child and parents' reports of trauma symptoms was 12.71 prior to treatment and that score dropped to 3.35 after completing treatment. This is significant as it shows that the treatment helped parents/caregivers to have a better understanding of what their child is experiencing.

In 2015, Hope Haven was able to obtain a grant to add a full-time Therapist who provide this treatment to the children at CODA's domestic violence shelter and CAPA's emergency shelter.

TRAUMA FOCUSED EQUINE THERAPY

In 2015, we piloted a program that takes our Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) out of the office setting and into the farm with the help of some four-legged friends: horses! The results we saw were remarkable! Seven children completed this treatment in 2015. The average trauma scores before treatment was 24 and after completion of Trauma Focused Equine Therapy, that score dropped to an average of 6.7.

I'm a foster parent of a 7 year old little boy that we will call "Ben". Ben has been in 15 different placement homes in the past 2 years. This cute little kid who looks like he wouldn't hurt a fly had so much anger and rage inside of him. If something was said to him, his attitude, disrespect and violent behavior would have one worried and on alert. We have been to different mental health therapies for help, but none seemed to get his attention or respect. Since we have been going to equine therapy, there has been a BIG difference in Ben's life and in our lives. My family sees a significant



change in Ben and his attitude. He is learning about himself when he is working with the horses. He gets all the bad things that happened to him out by talking and trusting his horse friends and therapists. Equine Therapy has taught Ben to be calm and loving, not just to animals, but to everyone he meets. My family and I hope this program continues to serve other children and families, because we are living proof that equine therapy can make a difference in a child's life, it has for Ben.

PARENT CHILD INTERACTION THERAPY (PCIT)

At Hope Haven, we believe that ALL parents want to be good parents. Sometimes when young children's behaviors gets out of control, parents are at a lost and feel completely helpless. This causes intense stress and tension that can lead to negative results for both parent and child. PCIT is an evidence based intensive one on one parent coaching therapy that empowers parents to learn effective skills to manage their child's challenging behaviors.



- 100% of parents who participated in PCIT increased their ability to give their child positive attention for desired behaviors
- Parents rate their child's behavioral issues utilizing the Eyberg Child Behavior Checklist (ECBI). The average decrease in behavioral issues that parents report after completing treatment was 24 points, which is considered clinically significant
- 90% of parents who completed PCIT reported that treatment improved other parts of their life (family and other relationships, mood, etc.)




VOLUNTEER SPOLTLIGHT
