Art Around Town

The Art Around Town program gets art “out of the gallery” and into the community. This allows people who might never set foot in a gallery to experience visual art. This program also demonstrates the high standard of local art creating an appreciation of our homegrown talent. NAC is always looking for new locations for either pop-up or ongoing exhibits. Exhibitors must be Nanaimo Arts Council members. All decisions of the jury and hanging groups are final. All work must be original. There is no charge to exhibit. Current ongoing locations include:

Vancouver Island Conference Centre - EJ Hughes Gallery Hallway, 101 Gordon Street, entrance off Commercial Street, contact nacdirectorbf@nanaimoartscouncil.ca for more information

- All 2D mediums accepted: painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, mixed materials, original works of art only (not applicable to photography)
- The exhibit will be rotated every four months
- A maximum of 5 digital images of work labelled with title, medium, size and date completed must be submitted by the deadline for jurying
- Work must be for sale. Commission is 20 %
- All works must meet a minimum dimension requirement of 36”x36” or equivalent of 1296 sq ft
- No work can exceed 70 pounds in weight
- All works must be hang-ready, with appropriate wire to sustain the work’s weight

- The exhibit will be rotated every two months
- Work will be juried by the Hanging Committee on the day of hanging
- Work may be for sale. Commission is 20 %
- Outside dimensions must be NO LARGER THAN 36 inches in the longest dimension
- All work must be hanging ready with braided-wire hangers
- Space is limited so only one piece per artist will be hung

- The exhibit will be rotated every two months
- Work will be juried by the Hanging Committee on the day of hanging
- Work may not be advertised for sale. Patrons will be referred to NAC if interested in purchasing. Commission is 20%.
- All works must be labeled on the front and back with artist name & name of the piece
- Medium sized work is being accepted
- All work must be hanging ready with braided-wire hangers
- Due to the height of the hanging space it is recommended that works that do not need to be closely examined are more effective in this location
- Space is limited so only one piece per artist will be hung
