JEFF STEFAN

With respect, cheers to everybody!

JACK RONALDSON turns on the radio to Middle Eastern oriental music, while JULIE-JULIETTE finishes serving other customers. Then, she takes off her shirt

and slacks, puts them on a chair in the bar, puts the tips in her personal safe. JULIE-JULIETTE keeps only her underwear on and starts dancing to the wild music while everyone whistles and yells and claps their hands with great joy. While JULIE-JULIETTE is dancing to the radio music, she keeps on bartending and waitressing; the customers at the Small Town Bar work up a huge appetite and order more food and drink.

JEFF STEFAN

You’re absolutely right, George, that’s the truth!

All those rich business people, industrialists, hi-techies and so on, lookout for their work places so everyone profits from them. The government profits, the country profits from the income tax, and so on. It’s only us from the lower middle class and the poor that can’t even earn minimum wage.

JEFF STEFAN

That's who has the last word. This Prime Minister is ruining the country slowly but surely...it's no wonder that lots of places in the world are putting sanctions on Israel, and it's no wonder that anti-Semitism is on the rise and lots of people hate Israelis, especially Jews.

FRED BORNE

I don't believe what I'm hearing here, you're not making sense....you're talking rubbish.

Fred is upset and doesn't know how to respond but keeps his cool for now and drinks his beer. He knows that the others are right but doesn't want to justify the facts. He stubbornly keeps his pride, too stubbornly.

JACK RONALDSON

Hey Fred, have another beer...it's on the house

JOHNNY JOHN

Don't take it to heart, pal, there are facts and there's nothing to argue about. As long as the government doesn't look out for the simple citizens from the weaker sectors – the middle

and poor classes, then there will be a real catastrophe coming.

JACK RONALDSON

I’ll tell you something, guys, the ones that are earning at the expense of all the others are the weapons industrialists...because there is no shortage of wars in the world, terrorism and such. The ammunition dealers make all kinds of weapons, guns, grenades, bombs, shells, missiles and all kinds of other types of weaponry. They make tanks and all kinds of machines.

FRED BORNE

Okay..! I kept quiet till now...you're talking so much rubbish and I can't listen any more. The right wing government and the left-wing opposition forever! I'm in favor of this Prime Minister and I'm in favor of this government, and that's a fact!

Fred Borne keeps to his opinion without worrying about the responses of the others, full of pride. He drinks his drink with a big smile on his face, his friends look at him and view him as a total idiot, but they keep on talking.

JEFF STEFAN

Our friend, Fred Borne, is so stubborn, even more than Haya and he keeps to his ideas without listening to anything that’s being said or anything that comes out of his own mouth.

GEORGE BIRD

We need to get rid of the high cost of living, to make prices come down in all the stores and businesses and in all the pharmacies and food outlets; we need to lower the price of real estate by at least 80% and the municipal taxes and utilities by at least 70%. JACK RONALDSON

Coming right up guys.

JEFF STEFAN

The Prime Minister and all the rest of his cabinet keep on making promises right and left but when it comes time to act none of them do anything.

FRED BORNE

That's not true, you're wrong. Our leaders are doing all they can. Instead of complaining, start to see the positive side of things. Start appreciating your leader and the government so you can appreciate what they're doing. Stop supporting the left and be happy that there's a good leader worrying about the people of this country

– and our leader is looking out for us.

JOHNNY JOHN

You're an idiot, Fred, you're wrong and you know it.

It's no wonder you're such a right extremist...

GEORGE BIRD

We have to have a serious revolt in this country, to bring down the current government and to get a better one that...to choose the perfect leader that would lead this country wisely and with respect without doing damage. The citizens in this country can't go on living the way we do now, even though so many think like Fred, I think it's possible to make serious changes in our beautiful and well-developed country.

JEFF STEFAN

In the meantime, we're just talking, but we should

think about what we can do about this. JACK RONALDSON serves our friends their orders.

JACK RONALDSON

Here are your orders, guys, dig in!

JEFF STEFAN

Tell us your opinion Jack; I’d like to hear what you think about all this.

JACK RONALDSON

Every one of us is allowed to express their opinion and think whatever way as to what’s right as far as I’m concerned. But you’re all right, except for Fred, who thinks that the current situation is the best.

JOHNNY JOHN

It’s a good thing the Prime Minister and his cabinet aren’t here right now, I’d let them have it and demand they rectify the situation for the entire population.

GEORGE BIRD

In today’s reality, it’s hard for young people to survive. No matter how much they work and struggle. Even if they study and find work in their profession it will still be hard for them to earn enough to live on. And for the married ones it’s even harder to save enough to buy a home.

JOHNNY JOHN

It's hard for young couples to get a mortgage. You're lucky your wife already has a home.

GEORGE BIRD

JULIE-JULIETTE

JACK RONALDSON

JACK RONALDSON

I'm glad you're enjoying every moment at work; at least you're happy because not everyone else is, and that's for sure.

JULIE-JULIETTE

I'm just putting these tips with all these others and I'll get back to work.

JACK RONALDSON

Okay, JULIE-JULIETTE, here, take some vodka neat,
no rocks...it’ll do you good.

JACK RONALDSON

GEORGE BIRD
