

Castillo de San Marcos

Thank you for participating in Find Your Park Plein Air. Since this event takes place on National Park Service property, please observe the following guidelines to protect the integrity of these historic landmarks.

Artists can set up in all grass areas of the Castillo de San Marcos, including:

- South Green
- North Green

Please refrain from setting up at/on the following locations (shown here in **burgundy**):

- Within the fort or ravelin
- Outer defense walls, including the seawall, Cubo Line, covered way and moat steps
- Parking lot



The City Gate is part of the Castillo de San Marcos. Painting is allowed in the grassy areas around the gate. Painting is not allowed in the main pathways or on the structure itself.

Artists can set up in the following areas at Fort Matanzas:

- All beach areas - Atlantic and Inlet
- Picnic area
- Marsh trail area and shoreline vistas

Please refrain from setting up at/on the following locations (shown here in **burgundy**):

- Boat dock
- Waiting plaza area
- Visitor Center and breezeway
- Boardwalks
- Parking lot

To protect the park's natural resources, please remain on designated park trails and paths. Also, keep public walkways, boardwalks and roadways clear.

To protect the park's fragile natural resources, please stay out of the beach dunes.

Please note that no painting is permitted at Fort Matanzas itself due to the remote location and the need to have National Park Service staff present at all times with visitors. Artists can obtain a ticket for a regularly scheduled visit to Fort Matanzas to take photos or otherwise be inspired by the fort itself.
