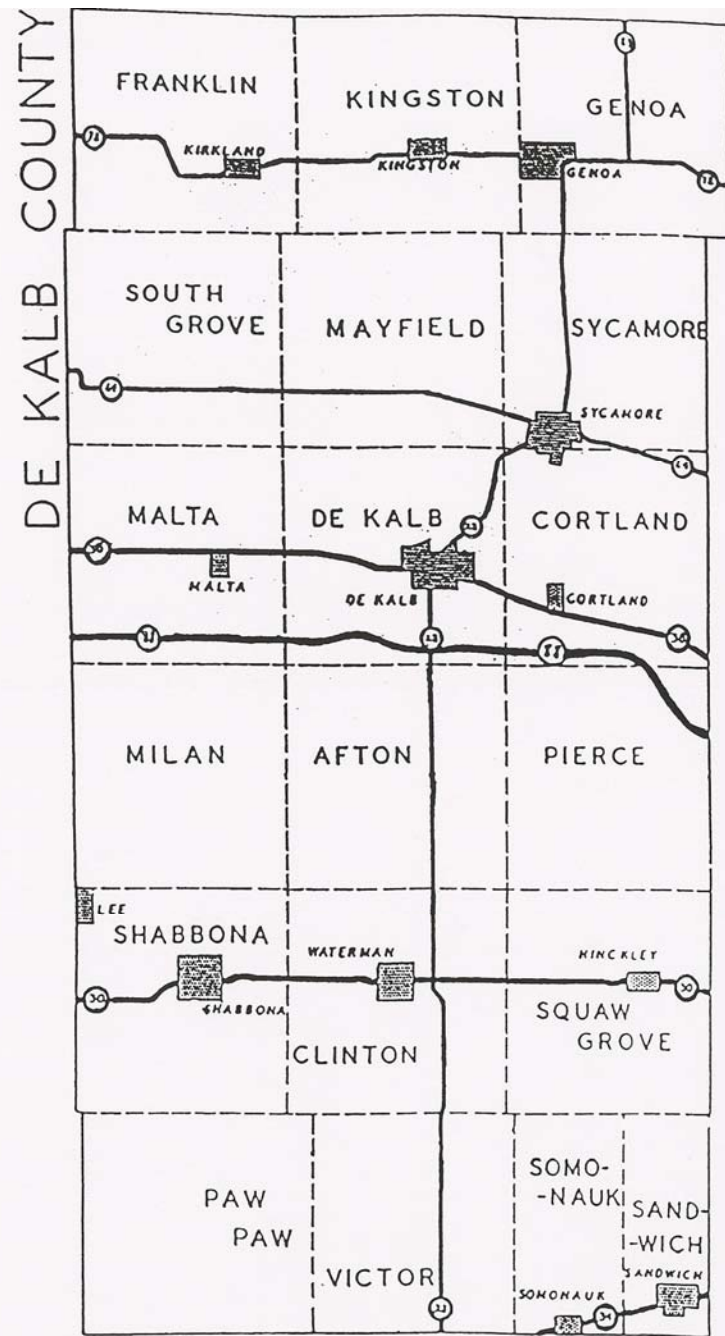

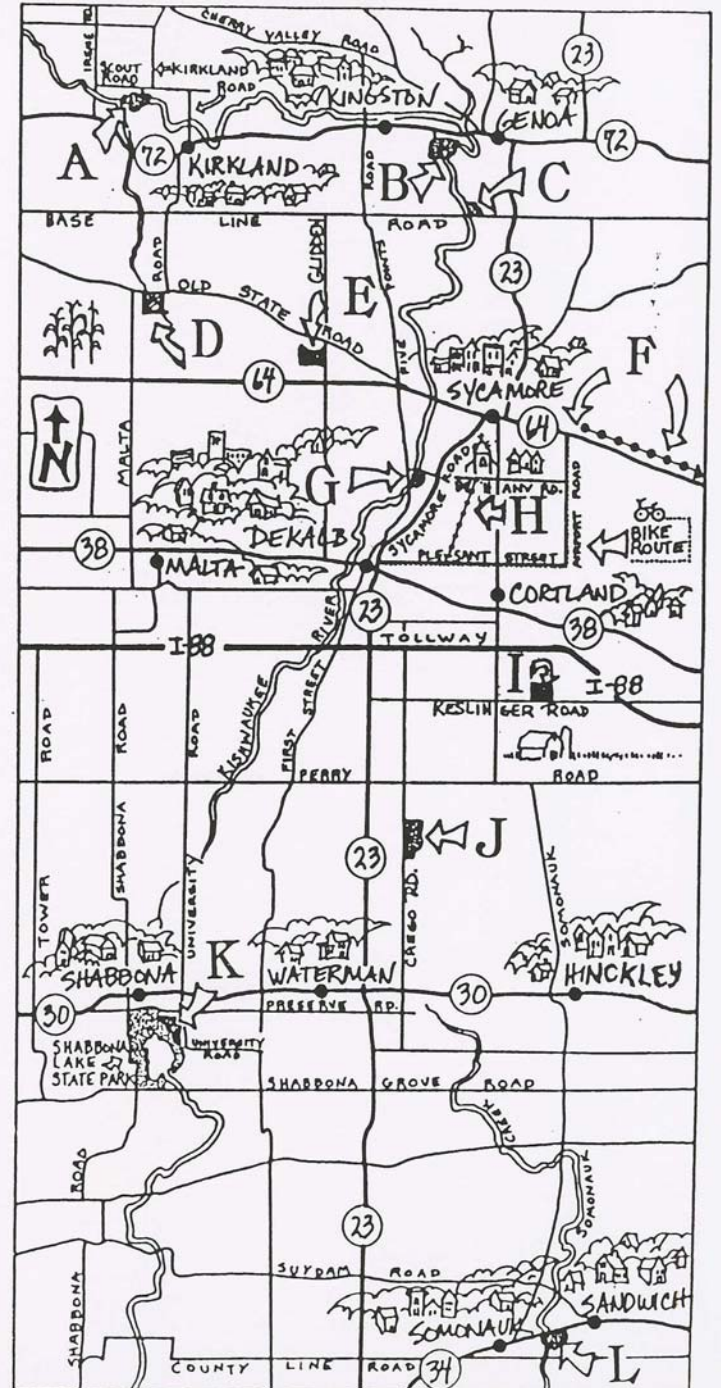
WELCOME TO YOUR FOREST PRESERVES

Comprehensive Anti-Poverty Support Services

DCCA offers a variety of services to low-income DeKalb County households that are experiencing various levels of need. These range from immediate to short, intermediate and long term needs. The basic qualifications for services are to be a DeKalb County resident and fall below 125% of the federal poverty level. Households seeking services begin the process by meeting with a Family Support Specialist. At this time a thorough assessment of need is commenced and appropriate services can be offered whether they be through DCCA or other services in the community.

DCCA works ongoing with families to attain and sustain household stability. Examples of services DCCA offers households are:

- Creating goal & action plans in order to overcome barriers to household stability.
- Assistance and advocacy in applying for governmental benefits such as SNAP, Medicaid, Housing, etc.
- Assistance in finding and maintaining employment including help in completing job applications, job

searches, resume/cover letter writing, and more.

- Crisis/emergency intervention.
- Budgeting and time management skills.
- Scholarships for post-secondary education.
- Linking households to appropriate services in the community.
- Free tax preparation services.
- Access to free fresh produce from our community garden.
- Access to DCCA work stations to use computer, phones, printer/copier, and fax to conduct household stability opportunities.
