



Cap Classique Jacques Bruère Cuveé Rosé 2010

Situated between the Breede River and Langeberg mountains in Robertson, lies Bon Courage Wine Estate. Here, the Bruwer family, produce a selection of fine wines, ranging from noble whites, classic reds and fortified dessert wines to the elegant and award winning Cap Classique sparkling wines.

Jacques Bruère - This range is named in honour of the Bruwer's French Huguenot lineage, the Brueres, who hailed from the Loire Valley. They are handmade from beginning to end in accordance with the traditional "Champagne" method.



Cultivar: 80% Pinot Noir
20% Chardonnay

Wine Style: Bottle fermented Rosé Brut

Winemaking: The base wine was kept on the lees for 8 months initially during the first fermentation. 10% of the Chardonnay was Barrel Fermented. The "magic of the bubbles" begins during the 2nd fermentation that occurs in the bottle thereby extending maturation on the lees for 36 – 48 months. After "disgorgement" (removal of the yeast lees) and "dosage" (adding base wine and sugar) the final product is left on the cork and then released.

Disgorge Date: April 2016

Winemaker: Jacques Bruwer

Aroma: Faint lemon and raspberry scent.

Palate: Silky richness filled with red berries and balanced with subtle mineral undertones.

Ageing Potential: Made to be enjoyed now or within 3-5 years.

Serve with: To be enjoyed on its own or with seafood based canapés. Truly versatile and can be served with oysters, salmon, tuna, prosciutto, sushi, Asian style dishes, rich cheeses and red berry desserts.
