

EARTHQUAKE CLOUDS AND SHORT TERM PREDICTION

Comment to "China sets 2020 vision for science" of *Nature News*

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A serious problem in the Chinese Academy of Sciences is not the emphasis on applied research, but a lack of democracy and freedom on sciences. For example, the United Nations published Bam Earthquake Prediction & Space Technology by No. 16 Seminars of the United Nations Programme on Space Applications and shared this yearbook to its all member states, including China in early 2005. However, many Chinese scientists and people wrote Shou that his web site <http://quake.exit.com> had been blocked after the Sichuan earthquake. Shou set up a new web site <http://www.earthquakesignals.com/>, but it was blocked in China, too. Simultaneously, some authorities of the Chinese Academy of Sciences claimed that earthquake prediction was impossible by media widely. If those authorities really believed in their claim, why did not they dare to debate with Shou?
