

PASTEL SUPPLY LIST:

Pastel Paper:

Several sheets of UART - Premium Sanded Pastel Paper or similar in a medium grit.

NOTE: UART comes in several grits - I prefer the 400 or 500 but you may use what you prefer. We will tape a sheet on a support which can be masonite or plexiglass or some other waterproof support that you can tape your paper on all edges with masking tape while you paint.

Watercolor Paint:

You will need watercolor paint for underpainting. Alternately we may use pastels and denatured alcohol.

NOTE: I highly recommend Artist grade paint even for the beginner and my favorite **M. Graham** can be found at the University Bookstore for a reasonable price, or ordered from online art companies. Choose a red, yellow, blue, and a payne's grey for underpainting.

Brushes:

You can use an old or inexpensive watercolor brush for applying the underpainting.

#10 to a #14 round brush or a 1/2" square or angled brush

A stiff bristle oil brush is also handy to brush pastel off an area to make changes.

This can be any type of stiff bristle brush.

Pastels:

You will need a selection of pastels, minimally approximately 15-30 in landscape colors. These will give you a good start. Expect to add to your collection as time goes on.

Additional Items Needed:

- Soft pencil
- Kneaded eraser (optional)
- Tape and support for your paper
- Protective nitril or similar gloves to protect your hands
- 12" Plastic see through ruler
- Palette - rectangular or other palette for watercolors.
- 1 quart empty yogurt or cottage cheese container for rinse water
- Small jar of denatured alcohol (optional if using pastels as underpainting)
- Wet (baby) wipes & Paper towels
- Pastels are usually painted on a vertical easel - you may bring a small tabletop easel if you have one.

Wear comfortable clothing. Bring an apron or smock to protect your clothing. If you have any questions about the supplies please feel free to email me at:
