## Class Descriptions

### Village

**Cock-A-Doodle Moo!** — Hop on the hayride—it's time to head for the farm! In this class, you will sing songs about the farm, including "Old MacDonald," "Hayride," and "Clever Cows." You'll engage in rituals and playful activities with your baby, including infant massage, lap bounces, exercise, and quiet time. **Home Materials:** A picture board book with charming farm animals and the sounds they make—*Cock-a-doodle-Moo*, a CD of the songs heard in class, a Sunshine Jingle instrument for music-making at home, and a set of Art Banners for the nursery wall.

**Dew Drops** — Stop and smell the roses—and lily of the valley, and tulips, and pansies. In this class, parents and babies will play and move together to songs about flowers, such as "Jasmine Flower," "How Does Your Garden Grow?," and "White Coral Bells." You'll also hear traditional Irish music, dance a jig and move to the "Irish Trot." **Home Materials:** CD of beautifully arranged songs from class, a board book of colorful flowers—*Dew Drops*, a set of Art Banners for the nursery wall, and a Flower Bells instrument for music-making at home.

### Our Time

**Away We Go** — Hop on the train, get in the car, board the plane, and Away We Go! This class focuses on transportation, a favorite topic for toddlers who are on the go, go, go! Sing and play along with favorite songs, such as "I've Been Workin' on the Railroad" and "Wheels on the Bus". Explore fast and slow, smooth and bumpy, and high and low. Read stories about ways to get around. Shiny Dinah tells the story of a train, and Giddy-Up! has a horse, speedboat, racecar, and more to help you get where you want to go. **Home Materials:** Double CD featuring songs from class; two interactive story books—*Shiny Dinah* and *Giddy-Up!* to develop early literacy skills; Home Activity Book, and two harmonicas designed for toddlers.

### Imagine That

**Toys I Make, Trips I Take** — Think of it like taking a course inside a child's imagination. We'll use the theme of a toy shop to make our pretend-creations, using rhythm and songs with every imaginary saw, hammer, and nail. The result is building the preschooler's sense of a sequence of events, which is good for storytelling, as well as making his ideas a reality. **Home Materials:** Two books—*If I Had a Big Blue Boat* and *Tippity Tuppity Too*, Toys I Make, Trips I Take Play Set, Two Home CDs, Family Activity Book, and a drum.

### Family Time

With older children ready to show the little ones how it's done and the younger ones eager to learn, *Family Time* becomes a multi-layered learning environment. From story time, family jams, puppet play and happy singing – all *Family Time* activities encourage discovery and exploration and foster sharing and social skills. In this special class, your children will strengthen their ties with each other and you. It's hard to find things you can all do together, but in Family Time you'll discover just how far music and together time can go! (*Digital home materials included*)

~ **Family Time Family & Friends:** Sing, dance, rhyme, move, and play your way through this celebration of why our very special **Family & Friends** matter so much! Using our imaginations, we'll visit our friends' houses, interact with family, go to the market, play with playmates, and more. Everyone is invited to make music with our family and friends!

~ **Family Time Rhyme Around Town:** Up and at 'em! Use your imaginations to hit the town: Down the street to the bake shop, the cobbler's shop, the grocery store, and even the doctor's office as we move, move, move through our busy, busy day. Then, back home again to relax and get ready for bed. Come along for a great adventure as we **Rhyme Around Town!**

~ **Family Time On the Go!** : Children always seem to be on the go, which makes this unit just their speed! You'll use locomotor skills and active imaginations to drive in cars, chug along in trains, and bounce on pogo sticks. You'll bumpity-bump, zippity-zoom, and stop-and-go-and-stop-and-go, because it's non-stop learning when you're **On the Go!**

### Music for the Young Child

**Semester Two** — Playing simple musical patterns and songs on the featured instrument from the first session—the glockenspiel—is a central focus this semester. While learning to sing a melody, and then play the pattern on the glockenspiel, we'll delve deeper into the understanding of musical concepts such as piano and forte through orchestra-style music such as the William Tell Overture and Peter and the Wolf. Music appreciation and understanding continues with a complete introduction to the instruments—and the families in which they're grouped—of the orchestra. **Home Materials:** Children's Folder with stickers, games bag, and Music At Home Cards, Family Songbook, and Home CD of music from class.

**Semester Three** — Appalachian music is a featured musical style this semester. First, you and your child will build a two-stringed dulcimer instrument with materials that we'll provide. Then in class we'll learn to play chords and simple melodies on the instrument you built together. We'll also explore rhythm concepts through dance with an introduction to the basic steps in jazz, ballet, and tap dances. Your Home Materials include dulcimer-making materials, activity cards, and music that features recordings from Appalachia, African-America, and Native American music, as well as the Western Art music of the Nutcracker Suite.

**Home Materials:** Children's Folder with stickers, games bag, and Music At Home Cards, Family Songbook, Home CD of music from class, and dulcimer.
