




Glenwood Water Line & North Colfax Roadway Reconstruction Project



Glenwood Water Line



- Line Constructed in 1910
- Clay and concrete sections of line with lead joints
- Conveys drinking water from Glenwood Artesian Well
- Line exposed in many places between North Palouse Rd and North Fork of the Palouse River
- Approximately 29,800 Feet
- Joints are failing
- Approximately 80% of the city's supply of drinking water
- Runs across river many times and through private properties without easements
- In city's capital improvement plan the last twenty years
- Engineering underway thanks to State CERB Grant.
- Proposed trajectory along North Palouse Rd/Cedar Streets
- Total Estimated Cost: \$3,500,000

North Palouse/Oak/Cedar Streets



- North Palouse River Rd
 - Currently gravel road
 - Length 2.61 miles
 - Want to BST road from Colfax Meatpacking plant to entrance of Red Tail Ridge Subdivision
 - Annexed area in 2007, regional route.
 - Area in danger of eroding into river.
- Oak & Cedar Street Couplet (8th to 11th Street)
 - Both roads rated 33 (TIB)
 - Length: 0.27 miles (Each Road)
 - Base failing on Oak Street/Multiple patches
 - Provides access to McDonald Park and Golf
- Total Estimated Cost: \$2,000,000
