We had an excellent group of very creative printmakers this year - just look at the collage of the images from the Florence Workshop book below.


The highlights include our amazing walk with Elisabetta Cappugi, the Art Historian. We all met in Piazza della Signoria at 9am on the 14 May near the Loggia to discover hundreds of people celebrating Dante's 750th birthday. There was a pageant in true Florentine style with a band made up of old brass instruments and drums with those in the procession in costumes from the 15th century, very stirring stuff. When we looked around almost everyone was reading aloud from 'The Inferno', including a group of policemen standing nearby, imagine our policemen at home being involved in such a thing!

Next we visited Orsanmichele, once an open market loggia which was transformed into a church as a vote of thanks for the survivors of the plague in 1348. The top floors were used as a grain store for many years and the outside is decorated with several niches with sculptures depicting the 'Guilds' by artists including Donatello and Verrocchio.

We strolled to the house Michelangelo built, Casa Buonarroti, very early sculptures and other artworks by Michelangelo are on show here also Artemisia Gentileschi's 'L'Inclinazione', a true gem. This palazzo has remained basically unchanged from the 17th century.

Our lunches were utterly delicious at the 'Forno' where a selection of freshly made delights awaited us every day. The 'Forno' catered for our welcome party and we will remember the excellent savoury dishes followed by a fabulous strawberry tart!

Manuel Ortega invited us to visit his studio and gallery one Saturday. Manuel is the professore at Il Bisonte and a well known creative printmaker and teacher. His studio is in a medieval building completely refurbished but retaining the old style. He shares the studio with another printmaker Gian Carlo. The studio is set up with everything a printmaker could wish for and exactly what we all would love to have at home.
